

Remarks on Board Ship Herald 1848

Wednesday Jan 5.

First part of this day a strong breeze from S.W. with cloudy weather. Lat. 16-42 Ship steered by the wind bearing N.W. by W. Long 38-21 latter part more moderate the watch employed in ships duty so Ends

Thursday Jan 6. First part of this day a light breeze from S.E. Steered by the wind to the S.W. at 2 P.M. saw the land to the westward saw a number of sailing boats the larger boat at 6 took a ship latter part bent the flying jib and set it hoisted a bark and fishing boat so Ends

Friday January 7th

First part of this day a fresh breeze from S.E. steered by the wind to the S.E. Lat 18-39 Ship steered by the wind to the S.E. Long 35-42 latter part continues the same saw a sail steering to the S.W. so Ends

Saturday Jan 8 Begins with a fresh breeze from S.E. steered S.W. by E. at 4 P.M. wore ship Lat 20-18 and steered to the S.W. one bark in sight Long 36-43 latter part continues the same the watch employed in ships duty

Sunday Jan 9.

Begins with a fresh breeze from the S.E. Steered S.W. by E. at 4 P.M. made all sail Lat 21-33 and steered N.W. latter part continues the same. so Ends

Monday Jan 10th Commences with a fresh breeze from S.E. Steered N.W. by E. middle part light baffling winds and squally Lat 22-39 latter part a strong breeze steered N.W. by E. saw 3 sails Long 40-19

Remarks on Board Ship Herald of Fairhaven

Tuesday Jan 11.

First part of this day a strong breeze from S.E. steered N.W. by E. at 6 P.M. steered off Lat 24-12 Ship steered by the wind to the S.W. Long 42-17 at 6 P.M. saw the land saw a fishing boat at 10 hoisted the topgallant sails so Ends

Wednesday Jan 12. Begins with a strong breeze from the northward steered by the wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. changed jib and mainsail latter part a little more moderate set the main top gallant sail so Ends

Thursday Jan 13th

First part of this day a fresh breeze from S.E. with heavy weather steered S.W. by E. Lat 28-44 Steered and then for them latter part a light Long 44-21 breeze all hands employed in working water out of the main hold so Ends

Friday Jan 14th Begins with a light breeze from the northward with fine weather steered S.W. Lat 29-46 latter part a light air the watch employed in ships duty so Ends Long 44-56

Saturday Jan 15.

First part of this day light air and calm. caught a sea turtle latter part continues the same set up the main rigging and wiren topmast rigging so Ends no observation

Sunday Jan 16. Begins with a light breeze from S.W. Steered by the wind to the westward. saw a brig steering to the S.E. Lat 30-33 latter part a fresh breeze from S.E. at 8 a.m. Long 47-19 saw breeches to the westward and run for them saw a brig steering to the northward
