First part of these 24 hours a light breeze from S.E. started at 11 AM. repaired the main topsail and bent it. latter part a strong breeze with thick weather. at 10 AM hauled the topgallant sails and flying gills saw grasshopper so ends

Sunday Feb. 20

Long 45-10
Began with a strong breeze from S.E. at 5 P.M. double reefed at 4 hauled a gill. mainsail fore and main topsails at 6 were ship. night part much thunder lightning and rain. latter part clear weather. But the fore and main topsails

Monday Feb. 21st

Lat 35-16
Long 45-16
First part of this day a strong breeze from S.E. started at 11 AM. at sunset hauled the fore topsail at 11 were ship at daylight set the fore topsail at 11 hauled it again so ends with a strong gale

Tuesday Feb. 22

no observation
Commenced with a strong gale from S.W. started at 11 AM. at sunset were ship to the westward at 2 AM hauled the fore sail middle and latter parts heavy squalls of rain at 6 AM close reefed the main topsails so ends

Thursday Feb. 23rd

First part of this day a light breeze from S.E. started at 11 AM. at sunset the topsails gill and spanker started at 11 AM. latter part the wind from S.E. with thick rainy weather turned the reef out of the main topsail started at 11 AM. so ends

Thursday Feb. 24

Began with a strong breeze from S.E. with thick rainy weather. at 1 PM shortened sail and were at daylight set the fore and main topsails and gill. started at 11 AM. with thick rainy weather so ends

Friday Feb. 25

Lat 31-19
Long 46-16
Commenced with a moderate breeze from S.E. started at sunset shortened sail the weather thick and rainy. latter part a light breeze from S.E. with fine weather started at 11 AM. with all sail set saw 4 sails standing to the S.E. so ends

Saturday Feb. 26

Lat 31-06
Long 47-10
First part of this day a light breeze from S.E. started at 11 AM. at sunset shortened sail at daylight made all sail and started west saw six sails saw some grasshopper at 11 AM the wind hauled to the northward

Sunday Feb. 27

Lat 31-50
First part of this day a light breeze from the northward with squally weather at sunset shortened sail at daylight made sail and started west saw one sail saw lots of grasshopper at 11 double reefed the topsails so ends

Monday Feb. 28

Lat 30-03
Began with a strong breeze from S.E. started at sunset shortened sail at daylight made sail and started to the northward on bent the fore topsail to repair at 11 AM. saw the land took a ship and stood off S.E. so ends
