

Remarks on Board of Ship Herald 1848
Monday April 24.

Lat 41-40 Begins with a light breeze from E.S.E.
Long 66-28 steered by the wind to the S.E. latter part
a strong breeze from W. by N. steered E.S.E. with all
sail set so ends

Tuesday April 25. First part of this day a strong
breeze from the northwards with cloudy weather
latter part the wind from W. by N. the weather
employed in making sail so ends
Lat 42-21
Long 66-46

Wednesday April 26

First part of day 24 hours a fresh
breeze from W. by N. steered E.S.E. middle
Lat 42-00 part thick and rainy latter part the wind
Long 66-38 came round to S.W. and cleared off. so ends

Thursday April 27. First part of this day a
moderate breeze from S.W. steered E.S.E. with
all sail set latter part continues the same
put new back ropes on the old main
top sail so ends
no observation

Friday April 28.

First part of this day a light breeze
Lat 41-12 from W. by N. steered E.S.E. latter part
Long 66-43 the wind from west. set down the fore
topgallant yard fitted the rigging and
repaired the sail so ends

Saturday April 29. Commences with a light
breeze from W. by N. steered E.S.E. latter
part the wind from W. by N. so ends

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Sunday April 30.

First part of this day a light breeze
Lat 40-20 from W. by N. steered E.S.E. middle and latter
Long 66-20 parts a strong breeze so ends

Monday May 1st. Begins with a strong breeze from W. by
N. steered E.S.E. at 11 am the wind shifted to the
Lat 39-38 southwards steered by the wind to the eastward
Long 67-46 saw several shoals of porpoises so ends

Tuesday May 2nd

First part of this day a light breeze from
the eastward steered by the wind to the S.E.
Lat 39-55 at 7 P.M. took a ship. latter part a strong breeze
Long 72-16 from W. by N. steered E.S.E. with all sail set. saw a great
many porpoises and caught three. so ends

Wednesday May 3rd. Begins with a strong breeze
from W. by N. steered E.S.E. middle part hauled
no observation the topgallant sails double reefed the
top sails hauled. G.B. main sail and main
top sail latter part thick and rainy with
the wind from W. by N. so ends

Thursday May 4th

First part of this day a strong gale
Lat 39-53 from W. by N. steered E.S.E. at 4 P.M. hauled
Long 77-56 the fore topgallant middle part spinnaker latter
part the wind from W. by N. steered E.S.E. with all sail set
set the top sails and topgallant sails
and fore topmast standing sail

Friday May 5th. Begins with a strong
breeze from the westward with cloudy weather
Lat 38-55 steered E.S.E. latter part continues the same
so ends
