

Remarks on Board Ship Herald

Saturday May 6.

Lat 38-10 from S.W. with squally weather the watch
Long 86-00 Employed in starting water out of the fore hold

Sunday May 7. Commenced with a strong breeze from the Southwest steered east middle part

Lat 37-17 with clear weather set the jib and
Long 89-21 main sail so ends

Monday May 8

Lat 36-35 from S.W. steered E by S with all sail set
Long 92-42 latter part continues the same

Tuesday May 9. First part of the 24 hours a
Lat 36-25 fresh breeze from S.W. steered East
Long 95-58 with all sail set. latter part continues
the same. so ends

Wednesday May 10.

Lat 36-10 All three 24 hours a fresh breeze
Long 98-47 from S.W. steered E by S with all
sail set. fitted one of the new Boats

Thursday May 11. Begins with a strong
breeze from S.W. with clear weather
steered E by S. latter part thick weather
so ends no observation

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Friday May 12.

Lat 32-51 First part of this day a strong breeze
Long 104-18 from S.W. with squally weather steered
E by S latter part clear weather with the
wind from the southward. painted the foreboard
so ends

Saturday May 13. First part of this day a light breeze
from the southward with fine weather, steered E by S
Lat 31-56 latter part a light air the watch employed
Long 106-13 in ship's duty so ends

Sunday May 14

Lat 31-12 All three 24 hours light air from the
Long 107-30 southward and calm steered E by S with
all sail set. so ends

Monday May 15. All three 24 hours a light air
from the southward steered E by S with all
Lat 29-50 sail set, made a fore royal yber saw -
Long 108-35 finbacks and grompusses so ends

Tuesday May 16.

Lat 29-51 All this day a light breeze from S.W.
Long 111-51 with some light squalls of rain steered
finbacks and blackfish steered east
with all sail set so ends

Wednesday May 17. All this day light air
from the southward saw some finbacks the
Lat 29-27 watch employed in making spungarn
Long 111-32 so ends
