

Tuesday July 11. Harbor Work

All this day fine pleasant weather
sent 2 boats off after water got a
carpenter from the shore to work on the ships
bow at 11 AM the bark wade came to
anchor so ends

Wednesday July 12. All the day fine weather
at 9 AM the boats arrived with the
raft of water hoisted it in took the provision
out of the fore hold and gave some beating
the carpenter to work on the ship

Thursday July 13.

All this day fine weather on water
on liberty coopered the coopers the bow and part
and calked the ship on the starboard side

Friday July 14. First part of this day squally
weather latter part fine weather stowed
down water in the fore hold the carpenter
to work calking the starboard side one
watch on liberty so ends

Saturday July 15

All this day fine weather
all hands employed in taking down
beef in the after hold and stowing
water in the fore hold calked the ship
on the starboard side and finished sheathing
the bow so ends

Sunday July 16. all this day fine
weather all hands on liberty
so ends

Monday July 17.

All this day a strong breeze from S.E.
sent off 1st boat North a raft of casks
after water one boat off. Taking
for bags at 4 PM the boat returned
with a kind of bags so ends

Tuesday July 18. all this day a strong breeze one
boat returned from watering for provisions
scraped the ship on the outside so ends

Wednesday July 19.

All this day a strong breeze
both boats returned from watering without the
raft sent down the main yard and filed it
and sent it up again and commenced
painting ship so ends

Thursday 20. Began with light airs and calms at 4
AM sent 2 boats after the water at 4 they
got along side with it got off some wood and
painted the ship on the starboard side

Friday July 21

All this day a light air with
fine weather one watch on liberty had a
carpenter calking the stern and fitting
the stern lights so ends

Saturday July 22. All this day a light
breeze with fine weather one
watch on liberty stowed down
some water & got off some recruits
so ends
