

Remarks on Board Ship Herald
Thursday August 3rd

Lat 21-42 Long 173-42
First part of this day a light breeze from S.W. cleared by the wind to the westward. Latter part the wind from S.E. saw breeches and ran for them so ends

Friday August 4th
First part of this day a light breeze from S.E. started at 11th at sunset shortened sail at daylight made all sail and started at 11th set up the fore rigging and taken down the main stays so ends

Saturday August 5th

Lat 21-28
First part of this day a light breeze from S.E. started at 11th at sunset shortened sail and hauled to the wind at daylight made all sail and started at 11th by 11th so ends

Sunday August 6th
All this day fine pleasant weather started off to the westward and saw some fin backs at night shortened sail at daylight made all sail so ends

Monday August 7th

Lat 21-16
Began with a light breeze from the W. at 11th hoisted all three boats for humpbacks and struck three and hauled from them all at sunset got on board and shortened sail at daylight made all sail and started at 11th saw some fin backs the water employed in ships duty so ends

Tuesday August 8th

Lat 21-18
Commenced with a light breeze from the northward cleared west at 2 P.M. saw one of the whales that we was lost to yesterday - and a line one hoisted all 3 boats but could not strike the line one at 4 took the dead one along side at 5 began cutting at 8 finished at daylight made sail and started by the wind to the westward at 4 A.M. began heeling so ends

Wednesday August 9th

First part of this day a light breeze from S.W. started by the wind to the W. all hands employed in heeling at sunset shortened sail and were ship at 8 finished heeling latter part a strong breeze so ends

Thursday August 10th
First part of this day a strong breeze from S.E. at 2 P.M. saw the land to the westward the island of Cook latter part continued the same all hands employed in stowing down oil in the main hold

Friday August 11th

Lat 22-12
First part of this day a strong breeze from S.E. started by the wind to the S.W. at 11th hoisted all three boats for humpbacks and struck three and hauled from them all at sunset got on board and shortened sail at daylight made all sail and started at 11th saw some fin backs the water employed in ships duty so ends

Saturday August 12th
Began with a fresh gale from E.S.E. at 6 P.M. hoisted all three boats for humpbacks and struck three and hauled from them all at sunset got on board and shortened sail at daylight made all sail and started at 11th saw some fin backs the water employed in ships duty so ends
