

# Remarks on Board Ship Urala of 7<sup>th</sup> 1848

Sunday August 13.

All these 24 hours a strong gale from E.S.E. at midnight were no observation ship sailed heading to the southward and hauled the foresail so ends

Monday August 14.

Begins with a strong gale from E.S.E. with cloudy weather at sunset crew reefed the main top sail latter part continues with a strong gale

Lat 21-45

Tuesday August 15

First part of this day a strong gale from E.S.E. by the wind under fore reefed main top sail heading to the southward latter part steered N.W. set the foresail and fore top sail

Lat 22-45

Wednesday August 16. All this day a strong breeze from E.E. steered N.W. the watch employed in ships duty so ends

Lat 23-55

Long 179-48 West

Thursday August 17.

All this day a strong breeze from E.S.E. steered N.W. set up the fore and main topmast and top gallant backstays so ends

Lat 24-42

Long 178-48 East

Friday August 18. Begins with a strong breeze from E.S.E. with heavy weather steered N.W. latter part squally and rainy double reefed the topsails so ends

Lat 25-55

Long 175-34 East

Saturday August 19.

First part of this day a fresh breeze from the N.W. turned the reefs out set fore and main sail middle part a light breeze set all sail latter part a strong breeze from N.W. steered by the wind to the N.W. repaired the main top gallant sail

Lat 26-17

Sunday

August 20. Commences with a fresh breeze from the westward steered by the wind to the S.W. at 16 P.M. tacken ship latter part continues with a fresh breeze with cloudy weather so ends

Lat 25-18

Monday August 21

First part of this day a fresh breeze from N.W. steered by the wind to the N.W. latter part continues the same the watch employed in repairing the main top gallant sail saw some fin backs so ends

Lat 23-33

Tuesday

August 22. Begins with a fresh breeze from N.W. steered west with all sail set latter part a light breeze from S.E. with squally weather saw some fin backs so ends

Wednesday August 23. ra

First part of this day fine pleasant weather with the wind from S.E. steered N.W. with all sail set repaired the main top sail and set up the main topmast rigging latter part continues the same set up the main rigging and main topmast backstays so ends
