Lat. 26-20
Begins with a fresh breeze from S.E. stowed S.W. with all sail set at 6 AM. hauled the top gallant sails and main sail at 8 hauled the main topsail and double reefed the fore and main at mid night the wind shifted to the N.W. latter part clear weather made some sail and stowed by the wind to the southward the watch employed in rigging up on old fore topsail at noon were ship so ends

Friday August 25

Lat. 26-09
Long 168-50
Commences with a fresh breeze from S.W. stowed by the wind to the N.W. main part calm latter part a strong breeze S.W. stowed by the wind to the N.W. so ends

Saturday August 26
Lat. 26-02
First part of this day a strong breeze from S.W. stowed by the wind to the N.W. at 4 AM double reefed the topsails middle part were ship latter part continues with a strong breeze with squally weather so ends

Sunday August 27

Lat. 24-37
Begins with a fresh breeze from the westward shifted by the wind to the N.W. latter part continues the same so ends

Monday August 28
Lat. 23-58
All this day a light breeze from S.E. stowed west with all sail set the watch employed in ship's duty so ends

Tuesday August 29

Lat. 24-09
First part of this day a light breeze from S.E. stowed S.W. with all sail set middle and latter parts calm saw one finback watch employed in repairing the fibb reeds

Wednesday August 30
Commences with a light fair from E.S.E. middle part the wind from S.W. at 6 AM saw sperm whales to the westward going to the N.W. leaved for them but they started off quick to the westward at noon got on board so ends



Thursday August 31

Lat. 23-58
Begins with a fresh breeze from S.W. at 4 AM the wind shifted to S.E. stowed off to the northward after the whales but night came on before we got to them at dark shortened sail at daylight made all sail and stowed S.W. saw two finbacks so ends

Friday September 1st
First part of this day a fresh breeze from the southward stowed west hauled and latter part calm tared down the main stay and repaired the fibb. so ends

Saturday Sept. 2

Lat. 23-55
Begins with a light air from S.E. stowed S.W. latter part continues the same the watch employed in ship's duty

Sunday Sept 3rd
First part of this day a light breeze from S.W. stowed S.W. by N.W. with all sail set latter part continues the same so ends
