First part of this day a light breeze from S.W. Latter part a light breeze from S.E. steered south with all sail set. saw some fin backs. No ends.

Saturday Sept 23.

First part of this day a light breeze from the northward steered south with all sail set at 4 P.M. shifted the main topsails. Latter part the wind from S.W. saw fin backs overhauled the fore top gallant sail and repaired it and bent it again.
