Saturday Oct 14

At 10 AM held a survey on the ship and brought in that she must go in to the wharf at 4 PM weighed anchor and went up near the wharf and let go the anchor and furled the sails the ship making five hundred strokes per hour

Sunday Oct 15

All this day fine weather one water on liberty

Monday Oct 16 First part of this day on board the sails and sent across the top gallant mast and yards at 4 PM hauled in to the wharf and made fast and furled the sails and got ready for discharging the ship making five hundred strokes per hour

Tuesday Oct 17th

All hands employed in discharging and putting the things in the storehouse the cooper employed in cooping oil the ship making at her old rate five hundred strokes.

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Wednesday Oct 18

All this day squally rainy weather all hands employed in breaking out the coals and storing it

Thursday Oct 19

All hands employed in breaking out the coals and storing the things.

Friday Oct 20

All this day all hands employed in breaking out and storing the coals at 4 PM held a survey on the ship and found her to be at her old rate five hundred strokes per hour.

Saturday Oct 21 All this day all hands employed in breaking out and storing away the things have a gang of calkers to work on the ship at 6 PM taken off the crew their daily wages found the ship was not back so bad as she thought

Sunday Oct 22

All this day fine pleasant weather the crew on liberty

Monday Oct 23 All this day pleasant weather all hands employed in breaking out the ship latter part finished and cleaned out the hold at 1 PM held a survey on the ship and brought in that she must be hoisted out on both sides sent down the lower and top side yards the calkers and carpenters to work on the ship
