Friday Oct 27

All this day fine pleasant weather had a gang of caulkers and carpenters to work on the ship stripping off sheathing and caulking her

All this day fine weather the carpenters and caulkers to work on the ships before stripping and caulking at sunset righted the ship up

Sunday Oct 29. All this day squally rainy weather with thunder and lightning

Monday Oct 30.

All this day fine weather hove the ship down. The caulkers to work on her before stripping and caulking
