Saturday Nov. 4 All this day fine pleasant weather the carpenters and calkers to work on the ship stripping and calking

Sunday Nov. 5

All this day fine weather

Monday Nov. 6 First part of this day fine pleasant weather the carpenters and calkers to work on the ship stripping and calking latter part a strong breeze

Tuesday Nov. 7

All this day fine weather the carpenters and calkers to work on the ship's bottom stripping and calking at 6 P.M. righted the ship up

Wednesday Nov. 8 All this day a strong breeze at 6 P.M. have the ship down and finished stripping and calking and commenced sheathing and copping at 6 P.M. righted the ship up

Thursday Nov. 9

First part of this day thick cloudy weather with thunder and lightning latter part clear weather the carpenters to work sheathing and copping

Friday Nov. 10 All this day fine pleasant weather the carpenters to work sheathing and copping

Saturday Nov. 11

All three 24 hours fine weather the carpenters to work on the ship sheathing and copping

Sunday Nov. 12 All this day fine pleasant weather Colpburn Dickinson Thomas H. Johnson James Macpherson and Albert Dene Dewart
