

Remarks on Board of the Ship Heavald

Wednesday Jan 24th

First part of this day fresh Breezes from the Northward heading NW by N the watch Employed Repairing the main topsail at 4 shortened sail at Day Light made sail with light winds from the NW heading South latter part strong Breezes from the Southward steering NW by N hauled the topgallant sails and Double Reefed the topsails the watch Employed on ships Duty Lat 35-10 S Long 154-02 East 50 Ends

Thursday Jan 25th

Begins with strong Breezes from the SE steering NW by N the watch Employed on ships Duty at 7 shortened sail and hauled to the wind at Day Light made sail steering NW by S latter part strong Breezes from the SE Lat 35-02 S Long 152-34 East 50 Ends

Friday Jan 26th

First part light winds from the ESE steering West the watch Employed painting the Mast Boat at 7 shortened sail at Day Light made sail steering NW by S latter part light winds from the SE Lat 34-57 South Long 151-46 50 Ends

Saturday Jan 27th

Begins with light winds from the ENE steering NW by N at 1 P.M. saw seven Whales giving NW hauled three Boats and gave chase But could not come up with them they were so shy at 4 came on Board at 7 shortened sail at Day Light made sail heading NW latter part fresh Breezes from the Northward at 10 A.M. saw the land and 2 sails steering NE the other steering south at 11 turned the Reefs out off the topsails Lat 35-16 S Long 157-32

Sunday Jan 28th

Begins with strong gales from the Northward heading ENE at 1 P.M. Double Reefed the topsails at 4 hauled the main sail and spanker at 3 hauled the fore and mizen topsails latter part continues the same Lat 35-30 South

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Monday Jan 29th

First part of this day strong Breezes from the NW heading NE by E at 1 P.M. wave ship heading West at 3 the wind chopped round to the SSE heading SW at Day Light made sail wave ship and steered West at 8 A.M. turned the Reefs out of the main topsail latter part fresh Breezes from the SE the watch Employed on ships Duty Lat 35-27 50 Ends

Tuesday Jan 30th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the ESE steering West at 7 shortened sail and wave ship heading SW at Day Light made all sail steering West latter part light winds from the Eastward with fine weather the watch Employed on ships Duty Lat 35-13 Long 151-17 E 50 Ends there 24 hours

Wednesday Jan 31th

commences with light winds from the ENE steering West at 3 P.M. saw a sail heading SE at 4 saw the land at 6 hauled the topgallant sails and flying Jib and wave ship heading East at 7 shortened sail at Day Light set the fore and mizen topsails Double reefed at 8 A.M. wave ship heading West and saw a fin Back latter part fresh Breezes from the NW at 10 set the main sail and Jib and saw two sails heading to the NE at 11 P.M. wave ship heading E by N the watch Employed painting the sternboard Boat and saw the land Lat 35-21 South 50 Ends

Thursday Feb 1st

Begins with light winds from the Northward heading E by N at 5 P.M. the wind shifted to SE at 7 shortened sail wave ship heading South at Day Light made sail heading East latter part light winds from the SE at 11 P.M. wave ship steering West the watch Employed on ships Duty no observation 50 Ends

Friday Feb 2nd

First part of this day fresh Breezes from the SSE steering West at 2 P.M. hauled by the wind heading SW at 5 saw the land at 6 wave ship heading East at 7 shortened sail at Day Light made sail at 8 wave ship heading SW at 9 set the main sail and Jib and saw the land saw some fin Backs the watch Employed nothing gave no observation 50 Ends
