

Remarks on Board of the Ship Herald

Friday May 25th

Begins with a calm at 2 P.M. sent the fore topsail and aloft Bunt the sail and set it at 5 light airs of wind from the Eastward steering by the wind to the Northward middle and latter parts continues the same the watch Employed Repairing the fore topsail Lat 09-22 South Long 156-27 West 10 Ends these 24 hours

Saturday May 26th

First part of this day light winds from the N.E. steering by the wind to the N.W. middle and latter parts light breezes from the N.E. heading N.W. with fine weather the watch Employed Repairing the fore topsail and got two davits out to lower the fore Boat Lat 08-49 S Long 156-42 W 10 Ends

Sunday May 27th

Commences with light breezes from the N.E. with fine weather heading N.W. by N middle and latter parts continues the same Lat 08-01 S Long 156-59 West 10 Ends these 24 hours

Monday May 28th

Begins with light winds from the E.N.E. with fine weather heading N.W. at 3 P.M. saw a large Bone Shark middle part hauled the flying fish Lat the part light breezes from the Eastward heading North the watch Employed Repairing the fore topsail Lat 06-40 South Long 157-04 West 10 Ends

Tuesday May 29th

First part of this day light winds from the Eastward with fine weather heading North at 4 P.M. unhook the fore top sail and Bunt another middle part a calm latter part light breezes from the E.S.E. heading N.E. by N the watch Employed setting up the flying fish gear and Repairing the fore topsail Lat 06-16 South Long 157-13 West 10 Ends these 24 hours

Wednesday May 30th

Begins with light breezes from the E.S.E. with fine weather heading N.W. middle and latter parts variable winds from North to S.E. with heavy rainy weather heading by the wind to the Northward the watch Employed on ships duty no Observation 10 Ends these 24 hours

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Thursday May 31st

First part of this day light winds from the East to S.E. with rainy weather heading by the wind to the Northward at 5 P.M. hauled the fore and main topgallant sails middle part squally latter part light winds from the N.E. with fine weather heading E by S with all sail set the watch Employed Repairing the fore topsail and painting the Boat Boat Lat 05-07 South Long 157-35 West 10 Ends these 24 hours

Friday June 1st

Commences with light variable winds heading to the Northward middle part squally weather latter part topgallant sails and flying fish latter part continues the same set the main and main topgallant sails and flying fish and got the Boat Boat out the watch Employed drawing and netting gears Lat 04-47 South Long 157-40 West 10 Ends these 24 hours

Saturday June 2nd

Begins with light winds from the N.W.E. with light squally of rain heading by the wind to the Northward and Eastward middle and latter parts light breezes from the E.N.E. with fine weather heading North the watch Employed on ships duty Lat 03-52 S Long 157-58 West 10 Ends

Sunday June 3rd

First part of this day light breezes from the E.N.E. with fine weather heading North at 3 P.M. unhook the main topsail and Bunt another middle and latter parts light winds from the Eastward with fine weather steering N.W. Lat 02-02 S Long 158-00 10 Ends these 24 hours

Monday June 4th

Begins with light breezes from the Eastward with fine weather steering N.W. middle and latter parts continues with light winds from the Eastward steering N.W. by W sent down the fore topgallant sail to repair it Lat 00-47 South Long 157-25 West 10 Ends these 24 hours
