

Remarks on board of the Ship Herald

Sunday September 9

Fine weather but cloudy mind light from the Eastward all sail set heading S by East Middle part the same latter part backed ship and stood to the Northward so ends these 24 hours

Lat 56° 40' North
Long 167° = 46 East

Monday September 10

Fine weather fresh breeze from E by East at 12 A.M. backed and stood to the Southward latter part ran Pleasant Island water impled in ship's duty so ends these 24 hours

Lat 52° 40' North

Tuesday September 11

Fine weather fresh breeze from E by East ran under the lee of Pleasant Island natives came on board got 2 pigs Middle part the same latter part water impled in ship's duty so ends these 24 hours

Lat 42° 00' North
Long 167° = 41 East

Wednesday September 12

Fine weather strong breeze from E by East some pinches steering on the wind at East Middle part the same latter part impled in painting ship inside so ends these 24 hours

Lat 1-49° N
Long 167° = 32 E

Thursday September 13

Fine weather strong breeze from E by East changing on the wind at East under topsails and courses Middle part the same latter part impled in painting inside so ends these 24 hours

Lat 7° 11' N
Long 175° = 25 E

Friday September 14

Fine weather with a fresh breeze from E by East all the same Middle and latter part same Course Island water impled in ship's duty so ends these 24 hours

Lat 4° 35' N
Long 169° = 30 East

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Saturday September 15

First part fine weather ran under the lee of Canal Island Middle part calm with rain latter part the same water impled in washing and scrubbing ship so ends these 24 hours

Lat 4° 28' N
Long 168° = 39 E

Sunday September 16

Fine weather Canal Island in sight at sunset doubled reefed the topsails steering South wind E by East Middle part backed ship stood to the Northward and Eastward latter part made all sail steering N by West Canal Island in sight so ends these 24 hours

Lat 4° 24' South
Long 165° = 38 East

Monday September 17

Fine weather light wind from East steering N by W untill 7 A.M. hauled on the wind heading N East doubled reefed the topsails and hauled the topgallant sails and fly like Middle and latter part equally so ends these 24 hours

Lat 4° 35' North
Long 168° = 55 East

Tuesday September 18

Cloudy weather and calm some sperm whales come 4 boats at 12 A.M. the Starboard and Main Boat got fast killed them both and got them along side at 6 A.M. and took in sail Middle part heavy squalls with rain latter part cut the whale in and commenced hauling so ends these 24 hours

Lat 5° 06' N

Wednesday September 19

Fine weather light wind from East at 6 A.M. took in sail heading N by East Middle and latter part water impled in hauling so ends these 24 hours

Lat 4° 20' North
Long 168° = 37 East

Thursday September 20

This day begins with light rains squalls at 6 A.M. took in sail more ship heading N by East Middle part the same latter made sail and finished hauling so ends these 24 hours

Lat 5° 21' North
Long 168° = 57 East
