Friday September 21

Y Fine weather light wind from East at 3 AM
saw sperm whales lowered 3 Boats but could not
come up with them at 6 AM took ship heading
to the southward all sail out Middle part
squally latter part the same so ends these 24
hours Lat 4-51 South
Long 169-14 East

Saturday September 22

Fine weather light wind from East at 1 AM
tacked ship heading NE by E all sail out
at 9 AM tacked again heading South with
light squally latter part the same so ends
these 24 hours No observation

Sunday September 23

Cloudy weather moderate breeze Island in sight
Middle part the same latter part mixed headed
to SE East tacked ship heading SE West all
sail out so ends these 24 hours Lat 5-08 N
Long 168-44

Monday September 24

Fine weather light wind from SE East at 2 AM
tacked ship heading East all sail out Middle
part the same latter part tacked ship
heading SE by E commenced showing down so
ends these 24 hours Lat 5-10 N
Long 168-55 E

Tuesday September 25

Fine weather fresh breeze from NE East heading
S SE West all sail out Middle part wind hauled
to the Eastward steering by the wind SE West latter
part the same watch employed in ships duty
so ends these 24 hours Lat 4-43 N
Long 168-52 E

Wednesday September 26

Fine weather fresh breeze from East heading S SE East
all sail out Middle part wind hauled to the East
the same latter part tacked ship heading SE
East saw sperm whales watch employed in painting
ship inside so ends these 24 hours Lat 4-40 N
Long 168-49 East

Thursday September 27

Y Fine weather light wind from East coarse NW W
all sail hauled Island in sight saw sperm whales
lowered 4 Boats did not get any sight over board
at 6 AM hauled on the wind heading SE by East
Middle and latter part wind hauled to SE West
with rain squally steering West so ends these
24 hours No observation

Friday September 28

Squally weather wind SE West at 6 AM tacked
ship heading SE East Middle part squally doubled
reefed the topsails latter part made sail ship
heading East watch employed in ships duty so ends
these 24 hours no observation

Saturday September 29

Cloudy weather light wind from East at 6 AM
under doubled reef topsails heading East at 9 AM
tacked ship again heading SE West latter part
steering West West all sail out watch employed in
painting ship inside so ends these 24 hours
Lat 4-50 N
Long 168-35 E

Sunday September 30

Fine weather light wind from SE East steering
NW West until 6 AM took in light sails and
doubled reef the fore and mizen topsails hauled up on
the wind heading East Middle part the same
at 6 PM tacked again heading SE West so ends
these 24 hours Lat 4-53 N
Long 168-35 East

Monday October 1

Fine weather light wind from East steering by
the wind heading SE East at 6 AM furled the
topgallant sails and fly till at 9 AM tacked again
SE East in the morning could see land in sight so
ends these 24 hours Lat 4-34 N
Long 169-01 E

Tuesday October 2

Fine weather strong breeze from East at 1 AM tacked
ship heading SE East Middle part the same at
2 PM tacked heading to the northward and steamed
latter part rain with heavy squalls so ends these
24 hours No observation
