

Remarks on board of the Ship Herald

Wednesday October 3

Cloudy weather light wind from East steering West at 5 AM hauled on the wind heading SE by East at 6 AM hauled on sail. No De host the same latter part made sail wind from West steering chart in observation

Thursday October 4

Cloudy weather and calm sent down the fore topsail and commenced mending it at 6 AM took on sail middle part the same latter part made sail saw grampses water implaid in mending fore top sail so ends these 24 hours

Long 169 = 196

Friday October 5

Fine weather light wind from ESE East all sail out finished the fore topsail and bent it at 5 AM hauled ship heading SE East took in topgallant sails and fly 5th Middle part the same latter part made sail steering West so ends these 24 hours

Saturday October 6

Fine weather wind East steering West saw Hards Island at 5 AM hauled on the wind heading SE water implaid in mending the shankers all the part the latter part steering West so ends these 24 hours

Sunday October 7

Fine weather strong breeze from S by South at 1 AM wore ship heading E by North looking main topgallant sail and fly 5th Middle part calm latter part light wind from SE East made sail steering by the wind SE East so ends these 24 hours

Monday October 8

Fine weather light wind from SE East all sail out steering SE East Middle part the same latter part saw Hards Island water implaid in painting ship so ends these 24 hours

Lat 4 = 440
Long 168 = 30 East

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Tuesday October 9

Fine weather wind heads to ESE East heading SE East all sail out Middle part wind changeable latter part wind E by South steering South so ends these 24 hours water implaid in painting ship

Lat 3 = 26 South
Long 168 = 006

Wednesday October 10

Fine weather light wind from E by South steering by the wind South all sail out Middle part topped ship heading SE East latter part topped again heading South water implaid in ships duty so ends these 24 hours

Lat 2 = 21 South
Long 167 = 156

Thursday October 11

Fine weather light wind from ESE East steering by the wind heading South Middle part the same latter part topped ship heading SE East water implaid in mending Main topsail so ends these 24 hours

Lat 2 = 11 South
Long 167 = 256

Friday October 12

Fine weather light winds from ESE East all sail out heading SE East broke out for pickles and Dred Apples Middle part the same latter part topped ship heading South water implaid in mending Main topsail so ends these 24 hours

Lat 1 = 53 South
Long 167 = 066

Saturday October 13

Fine weather light winds from ESE East steering by the wind SE East all sail out Middle part and latter part the same water implaid in mending Main topsail so ends these 24 hours

Lat 5 = 30 Middle
Long 166 = 426

Sunday October 14

Fine weather light winds from ESE East steering by the wind SE East Middle part the same latter part saw Hards Island at 7 AM lowered 4 Boats at 9 came on board at 11 lowered again with the same success so ends these 24 hours

Lat 9 South
Long 166 = 866
