

Remarks on board of the Ship Herald

Monday October 15

Fine weather strong breeze from East some the
saw some Whales to the windward but could not come
up with them. Middle part the same latter part
battered ship heading S. East water impleined
in morning main topsail in ends these

Tuesday October 16

Fine weather strong breeze from East at 12
battered ship heading S. East at 6 A. M. water
again heading S. East saw finbacks 4. Middle
part the same latter part saw sperm whales
lashed 3 Boats got nothing at 10 o'clock same
board so ends these 24 hours lat 6 Miles south

Wednesday October 17

Fine weather light wind from East saw
sperm Whales, going quick to the windward
lashed 3 Boats but could not come up with
them. Middle part calm latter part more
breeze S. East steering S. East all sail out
water impleined in morning main topsail
so ends these 24 hours

Thursday October 18

Fine weather light wind from S. East steering
by the wind S. East Middle part the
same latter part battered ship heading
S. East water impleined in morning main
topsail so ends these 24 hours lat 5 Miles south

Friday October 19

Fine weather light wind from S. East
at 6 A. M. battered ship heading S. East
primed the main topsail and sent it
Middle part the same latter part breaking
out water large and fixing them
sent out fore topsail shading sail so ends
these 24 hours

Saturday October 20

Fine weather light wind from East spoke
the Gorge. Compting of new part and gained
got a key part at 4 A. M. secured ship sold her
one barrel of pork Middle part steering
latter part the same so ends these 24
hours

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Sunday October 21

Fine weather light wind from S. East
saw sperm Whales lashed 4 Boats at 1
o'clock. Parted at them twice but did not
fasten to far off at 5 came on board and
hoisted up the Boats and and steered S. East
Middle and latter part the same so ends
these 24 hours lat 3 = 34 off
long 168 = 058

Monday October 22

Fine weather light wind from S. East steering
by the wind S. East all sail out one finback
Middle part the same latter part shocked water
in the fore hold. Grapnel fishing sharks so ends these
24 hours lat 3 = 53 off
long 164 = 346

Tuesday October 23

Fine weather light wind from S. East steering
by the wind S. East at 4 saw sperm Whales lashed 3 Boats
got nothing at 5 came on board and steered
our course again after the part and latter part
the same so ends these 24 hours lat 5 = 11 off
long 162 = 558

Wednesday October 24

Light wind with rain squalls steering
by the wind S. East at 8 more ship heading of
shore Middle part headed at and on the
fore part into the harbor and lat of the
anchor at 3 o'clock and sent a raft on shore

Thursday October 25

Fine weather strong wind from S. East got the
raft off and hoisted it on and sent another
on shore and left it Middle part heavy rain
latter part breaking out the upper deck
and got up after a raft of water so ends these
24 hours

Friday October 26

Fine light wind from the Eastward Middle
and latter part the same weather and shore
the rest steering same water success
these 24 hours
