Saturday October 21

Fine weather with wind in steering
Down Water. Latter part got off another
raft and hoisted it in and sent the
masts on shore

Sunday October 22

Fine weather with wind in steering
Down Water. Latter part got off 4 raft
of masts and hoisted it in and sent them
on shore

Monday October 23

Fine weather with wind in steering
Down Water and getting up 4 Banty loadrop
masts. Latter part hoisted up the anchor
and hauled it up shore and draped it again
in and there 24 hours

Tuesday October 24

Fine weather with wind in ship
city and sent them 24 hours

Wednesday October 25

Fine weather commenced smelting ship
at 2 of off house short and got under way
and came out of the harbour got the anchors
on the house

Thursday September 1

Fine weather and calm. Strangers Island in
sight. Masts and latter calm with wind in
in ships city and sent 24 hours

Lat 4 = 55 2/3
Long 162 = 55 E

Friday September 2

Fine weather with wind in steering
the same latter part sent one penstock with
in ships city and sent 24 hours

Lat 4 = 44 N
Long 163 = 26 E

Saturday September 3

Fine weather light wind from N East
steering by the wind. By 11 AM all sail and
Mast 24 part the same latter part hoisted
and sent to the harbour and hoisted
Lat 4 = 46 N
Long 163 = 36 E

Sunday September 4

Fine weather light wind from S S East
Mast 24 part equally latter part light wind from
N West steering S East in and there 24 hours
No observation

Monday September 5

Fine weather light wind from N West
steering S East half Smith Middle part
the same latter part calm with wind in
in ships city and sent there 24 hours
Lat 2 = 15 N
Long 165 = 00 East

Tuesday September 6

Fine weather and calm sent down the
main top galant sail and commenced smelting
it. Middle part and latter part the same
in and there 24 hours
Lat 4 = 47 N
Long 165 = 42 E

Wednesday September 7

Fine weather light wind from S S East
hoisted the main top galant sail and hoisted
it steering by the wind. By 11 AM all sail
part hoisted ship heading E latter part hoisted
again heading S West all sail on water in ships
in ships city and sent there 24 hours
Lat 2 = 13 N
Long 165 = 28 E

Thursday September 8

Fine weather light wind from S S East at 1 PM
hoisted ship heading E latter part hoisted
the same in and there 24 hours
Lat 1 = 59 N
