sweeping by the river East of the

calm water impaled in ships duty so
and then 24 hours

springs up from East East latter part
the same course at East all sail and
watch impaled in ships duty so
and then 24 hours

Friday September 23

Fine weather strong breeze from ESE
course of East off the part the same
latter part saw a number of porpoises
watch impaled in ships duty so and then
24 hours

Lat 47 off = 10 N

Long 168 = 31 E

Saturday September 24

Fine weather light wind from East
at 1 PM saw sperm whales lower 5
boats starboard got one and a whale at 5
came on board and secured by the main
at East off the part the same latter part
saw a number of porpoises watch impaled in
ships duty so and then 24 hours

Lat 17 off = 10 N

Long 168 = 12 E

Sunday September 25

Fine weather light wind from East

at 1 PM lashed ship heading of East
middle part the same latter part saw
sperm whales lower 4 boats all got first
starboard and Bow Boat got sperm starboard
shot her line West Boat skinned mounds
then 24 hours

Lat 38 off = 11 N

Long 168 = 12 E



Monday November 26

Fine weather light wind from East
at 4 PM lashed the whale along side and cut
them in and under rail while point started the
works hauling after part the same at 8 PM
lashed ship heading of East saw these 24
hours

Lat 41 off = 21 N

Long 168 = 12 E

Tuesday November 27

Fine light wind E by South steering by the
S by South all sail out loading while point
steering S by East latter part the same hauling
so and then 24 hours

Lat 40

Long 168 = 10 E

Wednesday November 28

Fine weather light wind from East East
finished hauling at 1 PM lashed ship heading
North off the part saw sperm whales
lower 4 boats got nothing latter part light
wind from N West course of East saw
these 24 hours

Lat 13 off = 11 N

Long 168 = 42 E

Thursday November 29

Fine weather light wind from N West course
of East saw blackfish off the part
the latter part hauled on the wire of East
so and then 24 hours

Lat 4 = 11 N

Friday November 30

Fine weather light wind from N West

saw sperm whales at 1 PM lower 4
boats starboard got one at 4 took him
along side and gutted him in the part
calm commenced hauling latter
part the



so and then 24 hours
