

Saturday December 1st

Fine weather light wind from East at 10 AM saw sperm Whales lower 4 Boats Mast Boat sailed but did not reach him at 6 came on board and hoisted up with baskets. Middle part finished hoisting latter part calm saw Sperm Whales lower 4 Boats but did not see them again so ends there 24 hours

Sunday December 2nd Lat 10th = S Long 169 = 396
Fine weather and calm commenced stowing ready gunn Middle part calm latter part stowing. Calm down light wind from N West so ends there 24 hours

Monday December 3rd Lat 19 = S Long 169 = 09 E
Fine weather light wind from N West turning East at 5 AM more round on the wind heading N of East Middle part the same latter part wind hauled to the N of East then by the wind North so ends there 24 hours

Tuesday December 4th Lat 31 = S Long 169 = 09 E
Fine weather light wind from E of East stopping by the wind heading North Middle part hauled to the N of East course N of East at 4 PM hauled on the wind heading N West so ends there 24 hours

Wednesday December 5th Lat 48 = S Long 169 = 26 E
Fine weather strong breeze from E of East at 10 AM more round heading South all night saw blackfish Middle part the same latter part steer N West so ends there 24 hours

Thursday December 6th Lat 1 = S Long 168 = 55 E
Fine weather strong breeze from N of East course N of East at sunset hauled on the wind Middle part the same latter part course N West so ends there 24 hours

Friday December 7th Lat 1 = S Long 168 = 05 E

Fine weather strong breeze from E of East course N West at sunset took in top gaffant sail and hoisted the topsails Middle part the same latter part steering on the wind N of East saw a ship so ends there 24 hours

Saturday December 8th Lat 30 = S Long 169 = 54
Strong winds with squalls spoke the ship side of ship Bedford Middle part heavy squalls latter part fine weather ship side in sight so ends there 24 hours

Sunday December 9th Lat 40 = S Long 167 = 26 E
Fine weather light wind from E of East gale with the ship side Middle part calm latter light wind steering N of East so ends there 24 hours

Monday December 10th Lat 50 = S Long 167 = 10 E
Fine weather light wind from E of East steering N of East Pleasant Island in sight Middle part the same latter part ran down to the Island so ends there 24 hours

Tuesday December 11th Lat 13 = S Long 165 = 50 E
Fine weather light wind from N of East natives came on board got a few coconuts the ship in sight Middle part shore of shore got a gun of the shore latter part course South smooth unblown in ship's duty so ends there 24 hours

Wednesday December 12th Lat 1 = S Long 165 = 50 E
Fine weather strong breeze from North course South Middle part the same latter course N by North so ends there 24 hours
