Tuesday Jan #19

Fine weather light wind from East implied
in cutting saw sperm whales lanced Seaboard
and Harbor Boat West got part at 5 took line
along side Middle part saw latter part
finished cutting and commenced sailing on ends
these 24 hours Lat 41° N. S.

Wednesday Jan #20

Fine weather and calm sailing Middle part
the same latter part saw sperm whales
lanced 3 Boats Boat got part and bore parted
on ends these 24 hours Lat 40° N. S.
Long 133° 02' E

Thursday Jan #21

Fine weather and calm saw a large whale
young quick to the windward lanced 2
Boats could not come up with him sailing
Middle part the same latter part light wind
from at West steering by the wind at East
finished sailing on ends these 24 hours
Lat 39° N. S.

Friday Jan #22

Squally weather strong breeze from at West
Middle part wind at steering E of East
latter part East implied in breaking out
from aft and and putting at down the
fore hole on ends these 24 hours
Lat 40° N. S.
Long 134° 30' E

Saturday Jan #23

Squally weather light wind from at West
Seaboard Island in sight at 6 of off
wind hauled to the E West took ship
heading at 10 of off commenced sailing down
Middle part wind light and squally latter
part Seaboard Island in sight saw sperm
whales lanced 4 Boats Harbor and Bore
Boats got part killed him along side on ends
these 24 hours by West Lat 38° N. S.
