with 200 lbs of desert oil and 1st the
part the same so ends these 24 hours

Monday July 1

Fine weather wind from East
laying off and on Middle and
latter part the same so ends
these 24 hours

Tuesday July 2

Fine weather light wind from
East shipped 4 men and 1 Tons of
keep Capt came on board and off
the Eastward Middle and latter
part the same so ends these 24
hours

Wednesday July 3

Fine weather and calm Middle
and latter part the same so
ends these 24 hours

Thursday July 4

Fine weather and calm Middle
night Middle part calm latter part
the Capt went on shore to if he could
catch the deserters so ends these 24 hours

Friday July 5

Fine weather light wind from
East Capt on shore Middle and latter
part the same could not catch the
deserters so ends these 24 hours

Saturday July 6

Fine weather light wind from E
Capt came on board Cooper threatened
to set fire to the ship in my presence
at 10 o'clock also the third mate Mr
Lewis Capt saw fit to let him run
away he says I have helped him and
ship and can burn if and all go to
the together Middle and latter
the same so ends these 24 hours

Sunday July 7

Fine weather laying off and on
Cooper deserted ship on water at 10 o'clock
Capt came on board and kept off of Middle
Middle and latter part rainy and
squally land in sight so ends these
24 hours

Monday July 8

Fine weather light wind from E
Server in night also on sand Middle
part under easy sail Capt on part
came at by East implied in ship
July so ends these 24 hours
