Fine weather strong breeze from East
Simpson Island in sight at 6
A.M. came to anchor off shore and
batter part the same as usual, the
H. H. H.

Saturday Dec 21

Fine weather light wind from
East replaced in setting up shacks
in evening then H. H. H.

Sunday Dec 22

Fine weather light wind from
East replaced in setting up shacks
Middle and Latta part the same. Sent ashore
a raft of C. H. for water. So called that 24 hours

Monday Dec 23

Fine weather and light
wind from the East. Took off a raft of water
and hoisted it in. Latta part the same. Sent ashore
on account of some disturbance
between him and the Captain. The second
raft was put in. That. The third raft. That.
That, and the fourth. That. That. That.
So called that 24 hours

Tuesday Dec 24

Fine weather and light
wind from the E. Sent ashore 11 shacks for Coconut Oil,
and took on board about 20 lbs of the same.
Latta part about the same. So called that
24 hours

Wednesday Dec 25

Fine weather and
light wind from the East. Sent ashore
22 old barrels and 27 old barrels for
Coconut Oil. Middle and Latta part about the
same. So called that 24 hours.

Thursday Dec 26 1850

Fine weather and light wind
from the E. Middle and Latta part about the
same. So called that 24 hours.

Friday Dec 27

Cloudy weather with a few
showers of rain from the E. At 5 A.M. wind came
to the S.W. and freshened. Middle part heavy shower
of rain. Latta part fine weather and calm. So called
that 24 hours.

Saturday Dec 28

Cloudy weather with the
wind S.W. Middle and Latta part about the same.
So called that 24 hours.

Sunday Dec 29

Fine weather and calm.
Middle and Latta part sent out for water. So called
that 24 hours.

Monday Dec 30

Fine weather and
light wind from the S.E.
Middle and Latta part the same
so called that 24 hours

Tuesday Dec 31

Fine weather
Middle and Latta part the same. Latta part
got under way and steamed out of the
Bay in evening then 24 hours

Wednesday Jan 1

Fine weather light wind
from the E. East at 2 A.M. discharged
petrol, other side and Latta part
steaming by the wind S.E. East so called
that 24 hours

Thursday Jan 2 1851

Fine weather light wind from
East same from whole. Latta
3 boats got one to the Starboard
Boat to hire along side and out
the line in Latta part heavy rain
under double reef fore and main
topsails so called that 24 hours
