Fine weather light wind from East
finished stowing down latter part
stowing up shacks so ends then
24 hours

Sunday March 2nd

Fine weather light wind from
East painting ship latter part
light rain squalls so ends then 24
hours

Monday March 3rd

Fine weather light wind from
East latter part painting ship
and setting up shacks so ends then
24 hours

Tuesday March 4th

Fine weather strong breeze from
East finished painting ship
latter part have shacks so ends
then 24 hours so ends then 24
hours

Wednesday March 5th

Fine weather light wind from
East have up anchor and
get under way and get the anchor
and the heavy shackle port steering
by the wind East latter part
have spinnaker hauled down
get nothing so ends then 24 hours
at 21 all day

Thursday March 6th

Fine weather light wind from
East the shackle in sight
shackle port steering by the wind
East latter part have East steering
West last mending fly Sails so ends
then 24 hours at 1-1400

Friday March 7th

Fine weather light wind from
East steering by the wind East
Halls and Knox Islands in sight
at 6 AM started ship latter part
run under the lee of Hall Island
so ends then 24 hours

Saturday March 8th

Fine weather light wind from
East got the other sides of the boxes
at 8 AM came to anchor and sent
2 raps on shore for water latter
part got it off so ends then 24 hours

Sunday March 9th

Fine weather light wind from
East at 4 AM got under
way then got the anchors on the
heavy shackle and latter part
steering by the anchor so ends
then 24 hours at 16 AM all day

Monday March 10th

Fine weather strong breeze from
East steering by the wind
East at 2 PM started ship latter
part steering by the wind
so ends then 24 hours

Tuesday March 11th

Fine weather strong breeze from
East steering by the wind at the
shackle and latter part the same
improved in ship's duty so ends then
24 hours at 1-1400

Wednesday March 12th

Fine weather strong breeze from
East steering by the wind
latter part same as West so ends
then 24 hours
