Employed in heaving out the ship. 12 men on. Carpenters to work. Rigged up the ship. D.C. S. Ensl.

Tuesday July 19th

Employed in refitting rigging. 12 men on. Carpenters to work. D.C. S. Ensl.

Monday July 21st Employed in refitting rigging in the loft and the Carpenters to work on the ship.

Tuesday & Wednesday same work continues. Thursday commenced cooping the sperm oil. Friday & Saturday same work continues.

Sunday 27th Baffles with fine weather. Ship lying along side of the wharf.

Monday 28th Fine weather. Eight coopers cooping the sperm oil. Riggers and Carpenters working on ship.

Tuesday 29th Eight coopers at work on oil. ship lying along side of the wharf. Carpenters and riggers at work on her.

Wednesday 30th Ship lying along side of the wharf undergoing repairs.

Thursday 31st Ship lying along side of the wharf. This day finished cooping the oil. Discharged the coopers.

Friday August 1st 1851. Ship lying along side of the wharf. Two coopers, carpenters and riggers at work.

Saturday 2^d Ship lying along side of the wharf. Sperm oil is all taken by the Decallion, Capt. Hume.

Sunday 3^d Ship lying along side of the wharf. Riggers and Carpenters at work.

Monday 4th Employed in fitting rigging.

Tuesday 5th Employed in fitting rigging.

Wednesday 6th Carpenters and riggers at work.

Thursday 7th Ship lying along side of the wharf. Carpenters and riggers at work.

Friday 8th Lying along side of the wharf.
