September 1st 1851. Lying moored in
Sydney Cove. This day finished painting.
Sept. 2nd Tuesday. Employ'd in bend-
ing sails and getting ready for sea.

Wednesday 3rd Employ'd in getting
ready for sea.

Thursday 4th Employed in getting
ready for sea.

Friday 5th Ship lying moored in Syd-
ney Cove. Pleasant weather.

Saturday 6th Light breeze and plas-
ant weather.

Sunday 7th This day lowered and struck
a right whale. Boat captured. Struck again
and the iron dunn.

Monday 8th Ship lying moored in Sydney
Cove.

Tuesday 9th Employ'd in setting up
main rigging.

Wednesday 10th Employ'd in sundry jobs
of work. Ship lying moored in Sydney Cove.

Thursday 11th Ship lying moored in Sydney
Cove. Hands employ'd in breaking out

Friday 12th Latter part of the day rainy.

Saturday 13th Ship lying moored in
Sydney Bay.

Sunday 14th Ship lying moored in
Sydney Cove. Pleasant weather.

Monday 15th Getting ready for sea.

Tuesday 16th Getting stores on board.
