Wednesday 12th Strong gales from
N.W. with rain. Steering
E. in whole watches. At
5 P.M. double reefed the
Topsails and furled jib
and mainsail.
Lat. by obs. 33, 20
Long. 175, 58.

Thursday 13th Passes with light breeze from
W. and W. S.W. Employed in
mending sails. Steering N. E. by
E. in whole watches.
Lat. by obs. 33, 10
Long. 178, 48.

Friday 14th Light breezes from N.W.
Cloudy. Employed in ship duty.
At night double reefed the Topsails.
Lat. 34, 33
Long. 178, 47 West.

Saturday 15th Passes with light breeze from
S. Steering N. Employed in ship duty.
Saw nothing. Lat. 34, 16
Long. 178, 05.

Sunday 16th Passes with moderate gale
from S. with a heavy sea.
Seudding N. till 5 P.M. then
hove to at harbour tack.
Lat. 32, 15.
Long. 178, 20.

Monday 17th This day passes with light
breezes from S.E. Employed in
mending main Topsail and
breaking out Stowage. French
Rock bearing W. N.W. 10 miles.
Hove to harbour tack boarder.
Lat. 31, 40

Tuesday 18th Passes with light breezes
from N. Employed in mending
sails. Hove to in harbour tack.
Lat. 31, 10

Wednesday 19th Strong breeze from N.W.
with light rain. Looked for
blackfish, struck, iron drum.
At 5 P.M. wore ship. Hove to under
double reefed main Topsail.
Lat. 31, 49

Carrying sail. Steering N.
Lat. 31, 32
Long. 177, 54.
