Come with light wind with squalls from the Westward middle part variable winds with squalls and rain last part much the same So ends these 24 ours

Wednesday January 7th 1852

Come with light variable winds and squally middle & latter part much as the first So ends these 24 ours

Thursday 8th 1852

Come with light variable winds & heavy squalls middle part light breeze from the ESE latter part light wind hella to ESE Steering N So ends these 24 ours
Lat 13.48 South

Friday 9th 1852

Come with light winds from the ESE squally weather middle part light wind from NE last part light wind & squally from NE heading NNE So ends these 24 ours
Lat 12.30 South

Saturday 10th 1852

Come with light wind from NE heading NNE middle part to moderate E breeze Steering N by E latter part much the same So ends these 24 ours

Sunday 11th 1852

Come with to moderate breeze from E heading NNE middle part to strong breeze from the NE heading NNE latter part less wind at 12 o'clock spoke the ship part from the west sea So ends these 24 ours

Come with light wind from the NE heading NNE at 9 o'clock the Captain came on board near ship & stood the same course middle & latter part much the same as the first So ends these 24 ours

Come with light winds from the NE heading NNE middle part light winds latter part light winds & fine weather So ends these 24 ours

Wednesday 14th 1852

Come with to moderate breeze from the ESE heading N middle part much as the first latter part to moderate breeze with squalls from the ESE heading N So ends these 24 ours

Thursday 15th 1852

Come with to moderate breeze from the ESE heading N middle part strong breeze with light squalls latter part much the same So ends these 24 ours

Come with fresh breezes from the ESE Steering N by W middle part light winds latter part much the same Steering N by W So ends these 24 ours
