heading N^W middle part Calm latter part a light
breeze from the west steering N^W land in sight men emp-
loyed So ends these 24 ours

Friday..27..1852

Corn with Calm middle part a moderate breeze from the
S^E steering S^W Squally latter part light breeze steering
N^W men employed So ends these 24 ours

Saturday..28..1852

Corn with a light wind from the S^E heading North
middle part a moderate breeze from the S^W steering
North latter part Calm men employed Stowed down 15 barr

Corn with a light breeze from N^W heading N^W at 6 o'clock
Shortened Sail steering S^W middle part a moderate breeze
latter part much the same at 8 hauled to the wind
heading S^E So ends these 24 ours

Monday.. March..1..1852

Corn with a light wind from the E^N heading S^E at
2 o'clock Saw Ocean island middle part a moderate
breeze & Squally latter part boat ship heading East
at 12 Saw the land So ends these 24 ours

Tuesday.. March 2..1852

Corn with a moderate breeze from the N^W heading
East at 3 Saw the Ship Canton packet middle part
a strong breeze Ship standing off & on the land
at 10 o'clock boat went on shore to get recruits in
company with the Canton packet at the boat returned

Wednesday.. March 3..1852

Corn with a strong breeze from E^N lying off &
on the land at 4 the boat came on board but accidently
got stove at 6 stood off shore heading S^E middle part
light wind boat ship at 2 o'clock latter part no altera-
tion employed repairing the boat So ends these 24 ours
