Came with a light E wind Standing off and on Wood's Island at 6. Stood off heading SSB at 11 middle part boat Ship NW light wind latter part much the same land in sight men employed mending Sails So ends these 24 hours

Thursday May 6th 1852

Came with a light E wind heading SSB at 5 boat Ship heading SSB middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind at noon boat Ship heading NW men employed mending Sails So ends these

Long. 172° 40' East

Friday May 7th 1852

Came with a light breeze from E heading NW land in sight middle & latter part of these 24 hours past with a moderate breeze men employed

Lat. 00° 13' South
Long. 173° 22' East

Saturday May 8th 1852

Came with a moderate wind from the ESE heading NW Squally middle part light wind Steering SW latter part Squally men employed So ends these 24 hours

Lat. 00° 33' South

Sunday May 9th 1852

Came with a light wind from the NE Steering West middle & latter part of these 24 hours past with a light wind at 11 Saw the land Ocean Island So ends these

Long. 171° 29' East

Monday May 10th 1852

Came with light NE wind Steering SW middle part light wind Standing off and on the land latter part light wind the Starbird boat went on shore to get recruits So ends these 24 hours

Tuesday May 11th 1852

Came with a strong breeze & Squally at 4 the boat came on board & the Ship stood off NW middle part light wind latter part a strong breeze from the E heading NW men employed So ends these 24 hours

Lat. 00° 02' North

Wednesday May 12th 1852

Came with a moderate breeze from E heading NW middle & latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind men employed mending Sails

Lat. 01° 05' North

Thursday May 13th 1852

Came with a light wind from E heading NW middle & latter part with light wind So ends these 24 hours

Lat. 02° 00' North

Friday May 14th 1852

Came with a light ESE wind heading NW middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with a moderate breeze men employed

Lat. 03° 54' North
Long. 169° 10' East

Saturday May 15th 1852

Came with a moderate E wind Ship heading NW middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with a strong breeze & Squally

Lat. 04° 57' North

Sunday May 16th 1852

Came with a strong breeze from the E Squally Ship heading SSB middle and latter part a strong breeze and Squally So ends these 24 hours

Lat. 05° 02' North
Long. 169° 00' East

Monday May 17th 1852

Came with a light ESE wind Steering NW at 6 Squally middle & latter part past with light wind and Squally So ends these 24 hours
