employed So ends these 24 hours.

Thursday May 20th 1852

Came with a light & N^W wind Steering W by S middle &
latter part of these 24 hours past with strong wind and
Squally Ship Steering W by S

Friday May 21st 1852

Came with a strong & wind Squally Ship Steering W by S
middle part with a fresh breeze & Squally latter light wind
and light Squally at 11 o'clock Saw Strong Island Ship Steering
W men employed So ends these 24 hours

Saturday May 22nd 1852

Came with a light wind Steering W at 6 hauled to the
wind heading S middle and latter part a light wind Steering
for the land men employed So ends these 24 hours

Sunday May 23rd 1852

Came with a light wind from the Eastward at 1 o'clock
anchored in the harbor at 7 set the anchor watch middle &
latter part light wind So past these 24 hours

Monday May 24th 1852

Came with a light wind from the E lying in harbor
at 7 set the watch middle and latter part Squally
lying in harbor men employed getting water So ends
these 24 hours

Tuesday May 25th 1852

Came with light wind & Squally lying in harbor middle
and latter part past with light wind men employed
getting water So ends these 24 hours

Wednesday May 26th 1852 middle & latter part of the

Came with light wind

24 hours past with light wind from the Eward men
employed getting water So ends these 24 hours

Thursday May 27th 1852

Came with a light wind from the Eward Ship
lying in port middle & latter part light wind
men employed getting water So ends these 24 hours

Friday May 28th 1852

Came with light wind Ship lying in harbor
middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light
wind Ship in harbor

Saturday May 29th 1852

Came with light & wind Ship in harbor middle and
latter part past with light wind men employed
