middle and latter part part with a light easterly wind with
Squalls men employed So ends the 24 hours

Sunday June 6th 1852
Came with a light easterly wind light Squalls Ship in harbour
middle and latter part of these 24 hours part with light
wind men on liberty So ends

Monday June 7th 1852
Came with a light E wind Ship in harbour middle &
latter part of these 24 hours part with a light wind &
Squalling men employed getting wood

Tuesday June 8th 1852
Came with a light S.E. wind Ship in harbour Squalling
middle and latter part of these 24 hours part with light
wind men employed

Wednesday June 9th 1852
Came with light wind Ship in harbour middle & latter
part of these 24 hours part with light E wind men
employed getting wood

Thursday June 10th 1852
Came with a light E wind Ship in harbour middle
and latter part of these 24 hours part with light
wind men employed

Friday June 11th 1852
Came with a light wind from E Ship in harbour
middle & latter part part with light wind men employed
So ends these 24 hours

Saturday June 12th 1852
Came with a light N.E. wind Ship in harbour middle
and latter part of these 24 hours part with light wind
men employed getting wood

Sunday June 13th 1852
Came with a light wind from the E Ship in harbour
middle & latter part of these 24 hours part with light wind

Monday June 14th 1852
Came with a light N.E. wind Ship in harbour middle and

Tuesday June 15th 1852
Came with a light wind from the E Ship in harbour middle

Squalling weather men employed
