Came with a moderate breeze from the E. N. E. Ship heading S. E. at 6 the Captain went on board the Ship. Salasook at 4 the Captain came on board near Ship and stood at 6 middle and latter part much the same as the first

Monday Sep 20th 1852

Came with a fresh breeze and squally from the E. S. E. Ship going at 8 Saw Chases Island on the lee bow middle part of light wind squally from the E. N. E. Ship going at 10 at 11 the Sun the land Chases Island at noon Saw Whales going quick to windward

Tuesday Sep 21st 1852

Came with a moderate breeze from the E. N. E. Ship heading N. land in sight middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with a strong breeze from the E. N. E. Ship heading N. land in sight on the weather beam distance 10 miles men employed

Wednesday Sep 22 1852

Came with a strong E. N. E. wind Ship heading N. at 2 Saw Downings Island on the lee bow at 6 boat Ship heading S. E. middle and latter part of these 24 hours much the same as the first men employed mending sails

Thursday Sep 23rd 1852

Came with a moderate breeze from the N. E. Ship going at N. W. middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind men variously employed

Friday Sep 24th 1852

Came with a light wind from the E. N. E. Ship heading N. at noon Saw Downings Island at 6 boat Ship heading S. E. middle part light wind and squally at daylight boat Ship heading in to the land latter part steering long the land employed getting recruits So ends these 24 hours

Saturday Sep 25th 1852

Came with a light wind from E. Ship steering long the land at 6 steering W. E. middle part Calm at daylight Saw Sidnams Island latter part a light wind men employed

Sunday Sep 26th 1852

Came with a light from the S. E. Ship heading E. S. E. middle and latter part much the same as the first So ends these 24 hours

Monday Sep 27th 1852

Came with light wind from the S. E. Ship heading E. S. E. middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with a light wind squally from the E. N. E. Ship heading N. men employed

Tuesday Sep 28th 1852

Came with a light wind from the E. N. E. Ship heading N. Simpson's Island in sight at 6 boat Ship heading S. E. middle part light wind standing off and on the land latter part standing to Sidnams Island men employed

Wednesday Sep 29th 1852

Came with a light wind from the E. N. E. Ship heading N. middle part light wind at daylight Saw Simpson's Island and Intervels Island latter steering S. W. employed getting recruits So ends these 24 hours

Thursday Sep 30th 1852

Came with a light wind from E. Ship heading S. E. at 12 middle part boat Ship heading N. E. latter part light wind land in sight and two ships men employed
