

Tuesday Dec 21st 1852

Came with a light breeze from the SE heading SSE under all sail, middle part light wind latter part much the same. Wood's Island in sight at 9 spoke the Bark Beacon at 11. Saw Spouts boats lowered the Starboard boat got home

Wednesday Dec 22nd 1852

Came with a light breeze from the E heading NNE at 6 the Capin on board the bark middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind land in sight men employed Lat 30 South

Thursday Dec 23rd 1852

Came with a light breeze from the NE heading SSE at 5 in company with the Beacon middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind at 11 Saw Wood's Island Lat 10 North Long 173.22 East

Friday Dec 24th 1852

Came with a light breeze from the ENE standing off and on the land getting recruits at 6. Shorter sail heading N middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind land in sight men employed

Saturday Dec 25th 1852

Came with a light wind from the NE heading SSE two sails in sight middle part light wind latter part much the same. Simpson's Island in sight on the lee bow

Sunday Dec 26th 1852

Came with a light wind from the E at 4 Saw a bark on the weather bow whaling at 5 spoke the Ship Napolian Captain went on board middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind from the NW

Monday Dec 27th 1852

Came with a light wind from the E Ship heading SSE in company with Ship Napolian middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind from the E heading SSE men employed Lat 00.45 North

Tuesday Dec 28th 1852

Came with a light wind from the E steering W middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with a light wind in company with the Napolian Lat 00.12 South

Wednesday Dec 29th 1852

Came with a light wind from E heading NNE middle and latter part of the 24 hours past with light wind men employed Lat 00.22 South

Thursday Dec 30th 1852

Came with a light wind from ENE heading SE middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with a fresh breeze from the ENE Ship heading SE men variously employed Lat 1.44 South Long 172.47 East

Friday Dec 31st 1852

Came with a light breeze from the ENE heading SE middle, latter and latter part fresh breeze from the ENE Ship heading SE Lat 2.58 South Long 174.20 East

Saturday January 1st 1853

Came with a light breeze from the ENE Ship heading SE middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind NNE Ship heading E men employed Lat 3.48 South Long 174.35 East
