two sails in sight

Wednesday January 26th 1853
Came with a strong breeze and Squally from the
W middle and latter part of these 24 hours past
with light wind from the NE Ship heading W
men employed mending sails Lat 1.48 South
Long 176.12 East

Thursday January 27th 1853
Came with a light breeze from the ENE Steering W
middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with
light wind from the ENE Ship Steering W Saw
Byrnes Island men employed mending sails
Lat 1.30 South
Long 175.24 East

Friday January 28th 1853
Came with light light breeze from the ENE Ship
Steering SW Saw Perote and Inf. Sars Island at 6 ball'd
to the wind middle and latter part of these 24 hours
past with a light breeze and Squally from the W
heading SSW land in sight Lat 1.53 South
Long 175.11 East

Saturday January 29th 1853
Came with a light wind from the SW Ship heading
SSW Clarke Island in sight middle and latter part
of these 24 hours past with light wind from the S land
in sight men employed Lat 1.31 South
Long 175.47 East

Sunday January 30th 1853
Came with a light wind from the S Ship heading WSW
land in sight at 6 noon Ship heading ENE middle and
latter part of these 24 hours past with a light wind
and Squally from the SSW Ship standing off and
on the land getting recruits Lat 1.38 South

Monday January 31th 1853
Came with a light wind and Squally from the
S Ship heading ESE Ship in sight middle and latter
part of these 24 hours past with light wind land
in sight men employed mending sails
Lat 1.38 South
Long 175.52 East

Tuesday Feb. 1st 1853
Came with a light wind from the WNW Ship
heading into the land two ships in sight middle and
latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind
at 8 Saw Perote Island two sails in sight
Lat 1.30 South
Long 175.08 East

Wednesday Feb 2nd 1853
Came with a light breeze from the Westward Ship standing
off and on the land middle and latter part of these 24
hours past with a calm men employed mending sails

Thursday Feb 3rd 1853
Came with a light breeze and Squally from the SW
Ship heading SSW at Ship in sight middle and latter
part of these 24 hours past with light wind and Squally
land in sight Saw Whales going quick Lat 1.29 South
Long 176.21 East

Friday Feb 4th 1853
Came with a light wind and Squally spoke the
Ship Coral land in sight middle and latter part of
these 24 hours past with light wind men employed mending
sails Lat 1.29 South
Long 176.35 East
