getting trade at 6 stood off shore middle part breeze and
squally at 4 carried away the main top sail yard
latter part men employed fitting a mother land in
sight

Tuesday Feb 8. 1853

Came with a light breeze from the E Ship standing
off and on the land trading at 8 steering NW
middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with
a fresh breeze from the ENE Drummans Island in sight

Wednesday Feb 9. 1853

Came with a light breeze from the ENE Ship steering
long the land middle and latter part of these 24
hours past with light wind and squally from the SW
Ship standing off and on the land getting recruits

Thursday Feb 10. 1853

Came with a light wind from the SE Ship standing
off and on the land middle and latter part of these
24 hours past with light wind Ship steering NW Sidman
Island in sight

Friday Feb 11. 1853

Came with a light wind from the E Ship standing
off and on the land two boats on shore getting
anchors at 5 got two anchors on board at 6 standing
off shore middle and latter part of these 24 hours
past with light wind standing off and on the land
two boats on shore getting trade

Saturday Feb 12. 1853

Came with a light wind Ship standing off and on the
land at 5 boats on on board Ship standing off shore
middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with
light wind Ship standing off and on the land two boats
on shore

Sunday Feb 13. 1853

Came with a light wind from the SE Ship standing off and
on the land at 5 boats returned with Chances boats full
heading SSW middle and latter part of these 24 hours
past with a light breeze from the E Ship heading SSE
Ship in sight

Monday Feb 14. 1853

Came with a light breeze from the E Ship heading SSE
at 4 boats lowered for black fish but got none middle
and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind
at 8 spoke the Ship Nimrod men employed

Tuesday Feb 15. 1853

Came with a light wind from the NNE Ship heading
NE Saw a Dy on the horizon at 6 Corn squally
middle and latter part of these 24 hours past with light wind
and squally from the NNE Cl. Sidman Island in sight
