Sunday March 6th 1853

Came with light winds from N.E. ship in harbor men employed in ship's duty three ships sailed from port namely Gratitude Waverly Alexander Gipsy another ship in sight at sunset middle and latter part passed with a calm

Monday March 7th 1853

Came with a calm ship in harbor middle and latter part of these 24 hours passed with a moderate breeze from the N.E. ship in harbor men employed in ship's duty
