

Ship Herald Lying at Strong's

Sunday Oct 9th

Came with light easterly winds and pleasant
breeze and cleared up the decks. Ends for

Monday 10th

Came fair. Lost sails 24 and an hour then lost
them on shore. Day ends fair.

Tuesday Oct 11th

Came fair and continued so all day employed
breaking out main hatch, and discharging bales
finished at 4 P.M. sent down main fly yard and corded
it.

Wednesday Oct 12th

Came fair employed scraping ship's bottom and took
on board 20 casks of sperm oil. Ends the same

Thursday Oct 13th

Came fair and continued so all day employed
stowing down oil stowed 20 casks. employed 2 boats
from shore.

Friday Oct 14th

Came fair and continued so all day
took on board 24 casks of sperm oil. Also came
and Atkins Adams sails. Cleared the harbor at 9 o'clock.

Sat Oct 15th

This day light S.W. winds with rain. at 8 A.M. the ship
Duch of Cornwall sailed for Sydney. Employed stowing
down oil in main hatch stowed 21 casks. Discharged 10 casks.

Sunday Oct 16th

Came fair and continued so all day all hands on deck.

Monday Oct 17th

Came cloudy and continued so all day. finished stowing
oil and took on board 2 boat loads of wood.

Tuesday Oct 18th

Thirday pleasant took on board 38 hundred of shooks
2 boat loads of wood and stowed them below.

Wednesday Oct 19th

Came from employed stowing shooks and wood in the main
hatch took on board 1 cask of ~~oil~~ and 1 cask of ~~oil~~

Thursday Oct 20th 1853

Came fair and continued so all day employed stow
provisions and wood. took 6 casks of water on board.

Friday Oct 21st

This day fair. finished stowing lower hold. and commenced
between decks. took 2 loads of wood and filled 4 casks in the
lower hold with fresh water.

Sat 21st

Came fair employed stowing between decks ends for

Sunday 22

This day poor fair. and pleasant all hands on shore
but myself.

Monday Oct 23

Came fair and continued so all day sent up King
Tappall Mast. employed setting up Rigging etc.

Tuesday Oct 24th

This day fair with light variable winds. sent 2 boats
fly jib and Mizzen top sails took a number of loads
on deck. ~~and sent~~ and sent took 45 casks
of fresh water. shipped 5 barrels and took on board
James McEwen for See Office Mr. Corbett and
Lady Corbett.

Wednesday Oct 25th

This day fair. took on board 1 barrel spirit and 1 cask
beer and 1 fly jib do. and the ship's Writings.
finished bringing sails.

Thursday 26th

Came with light winds from the West with rain took
on board a boat load of Terra. for ship's use sent
6 men to the wreck took up 7 chain plates. ship all
ready for sea Capt Terry on shore slightly changed
has him the so for the last 10 days.

Friday Oct 27th

Came with light. Westerly winds with light rain squalls
at 8 A.M. got under weigh and went out side with a fair
wind at 11 discharged Pilot and shipped on board 6 casks
employed the remainder of the day clearing up ship and stow
the cables. Capt on about the same. This ends my Harbor
Log
