with a heavy Gale with a high Sea Lat 24.59 Long 179.15

Came with a Gale from the N.W. near N.E. by E.
Carrying 2 reefed Top-sails and reefed mainsail at 10 AM took
in mainsail heavy Squall with rain latter part moderate
with a light baffling wind from N.W. to N.E. Carrying all
Sail Employed turning in Main Top-sail Racking
etc. Lat 24.59 Long by Chron 179.16. 23rd Day

Sat Nov 26th
Came with light winds from the N.W. and pleasant
at 8 A.M. Set Studding-sails Steaming E.S.E. employed on rigging
at 11 wind hauld W.S.W. Set Starboard Studding-sail
at 11 in Lat 25.32. Long by Chron 176.04 W. 30th

Sunday Nov 27th
Came with Calms and pleasant at 10 P.M. took a light
breeze from the S.W. Carrying Studding-sails on the Starboard
Side. Sp. Steaming E.S.E. Latter part strong breeze. and fair
Lat by Obs. 25.50. Long by Chron 174.01 W. 31st

Monday Nov 28th
Came with strong breeze from the S.W. and fair
Carrying all Sail with Top and Topg Studding-sail
at 8 P.M. strong breeze with heavy clouds took in Main
Topg Studding-sail. Midnight the same latter part
strong gale Set Topg Studding-sail for Fore Top-sail due
at 11 took a heavy Squall from the N.W. 2 reefed
Fore and Mizzen Top-sail. Lat 25.02 Long 170.40. 32nd Day

Tuesday 29th
Came with a Gale from the N.W. with Squalls and
one reef out of Fore Top-sail and Set Topgallant Sails
with a Topg Studding-sail for Fore Top-sail due at
6 P.M. took in Fore Topg Sails Midnight wind light all sail
Set Topg Studding-sail on both Sides latter part strong
breeze taking in and setting Studding-sails as the wind
alms. Employed turning in Main rigging on the Port Side

from the W.S.W. Set top and Top-mast Studding-sails and last
sides finished turning in and setting up Main rigging at
11 top-mast backstays & Co. Lat 25.34 Long 165.58. 34th Day

Thursday Dec 1st
Came with light winds from the W.S.W. with fair weather
Carrying Studding-sails on both Sides. Midnight the same
latter part light breeze from the S.W. Carrying all Sail
Employed on Main rigging latter part 25.46 Long by Chron 163.24
35th

Friday Dec 2nd
Came with light Westerly winds and fair weather Carrying
Studding-sails fore and Main Steaming E.S.E. & E. -
Middle and latter part Calm employed finishing Main rigging
Sent up new Main Topg backstays. Ends with light W.S.W.
winds and pleasant. Lat 25.00 Long by Chron 171.57. 36th

Saturday Dec 3rd
Came with light Westerly winds and fair weather at
8 took a strong breeze from the S.W. with heavy Squalls
took in and made sail as the wind abated at 11
took in Fore and Main Topg Sails wind blowing a
Gale. from S.W. Lat 25.00 Long 158.57. 37th

Sunday Dec 4th
Came with a light Gale from the S.W. and Cloudy
at 8 P.M. Single reefed the Top-sail and Main Sail
Midnight moderate Set Topgallant sail over Single reefed
Top-sail at 8 increased to a gale took in Topg Sails
at 11 2 reefed Fore Top-sail and Set Topg Studding Sails
forward Ends with S.W. Gale with heavy Squalls
with rain Lat 25.18 Long 155.55. 38th

Monday Dec 5th
Came with a Gale from the S.W. with Squalls
Carrying 2 reefed Top-sails and Courses. at 8 P.M. wind hauld
W.S.W. with Clear weather. latter part light N.W.
winds with flying Clouds employed finishing Main
rigging. Lat 25.26 Long 153.02 39th
