at 8.15 per Gall and ship it on board the Brig
Soc for Callapernia

Thursday Dec 22

Strong N.E. wind with Squalls Discharged ^{at 5.15}
all hands and ship Sabin Mc Donald for Mate
and Samuel Drow as Steward at 15 per Month

Friday Dec 23

Strong N.E. Wind with rain. Sent a small
boat for Skit use

Sat Dec 24th

This day Stevedores with rain at 11th in fore.

Sunday Dec 25th

Day calm and end with heavy Squalls

Monday Dec 26th

Calm with heavy Squalls and ends the same
Ship 2 Sennu at 22 per Month.

Tuesday Dec 27th

Calm with a heavy blow from N.E. Sent the
Paragon standing rigging and Main and sold it at
auction at 1 1/2 per Cent. per pound

Wednesday Dec 28th

Strong N.E. Wind. Employed taking wood
on deck Discharged Mate Drow

Thursday 29th

This day pleasant land the Paragon under and
sold it at auction for \$11.00

Friday Dec 30th

Strong S.E. wind with rain

Sat 31st

Calm in N.E. Squalls and heavy. Ship
the Henry & Foster for Mate Cam on board
and ended a Duties 2.

Sunday Jan 1st 1854

Commenced with rain blowing fresh from the South
ends the same &c

Monday 2nd

Commenced with fine weather employed on various jobs
breaking for wood, nails &c

Tuesday 3rd

Commenced with rain and more pleasant employed on
various jobs &c

Wednesday 4th

Commenced with fair weather ends threatening rain and
wind employed breaking for wood and other jobs &c

Thursday 5th

Commenced with rather unpleasant ends with a
moderate rain storm employed on various jobs such
as breaking out and stirring &c

Friday 6th

Commenced with cloudy weather threatening rain and
with light rain this day employed on various jobs &c

Saturday 7th

Commenced with ends with a rain storm this day
employed on various jobs left one Sennu at local hire

Sunday 8th

Commenced with ends with fair weather left on shore
at Church and crew

Monday 9th

Commenced with fair weather ends with a moderate
rain storm employed this day on small jobs &c

Tuesday 10th

Commenced with fair weather ends the same employed
on various jobs &c

Wednesday 11th

Commenced with fine weather ends the same this day
employed from 10 am to break out oil discharged four of them
at their low, selected two of them worked the whole day &c

Thursday 12th

Commenced with fair weather this day employed
from 10 am to break out oil discharged three of them at
their low selected the rest worked all day &c
