Sunday Oct 18th 1835

All these 24 hours strong Breezes and clear weather steering S. N. East under single Reefed top sails all hands Employed in ships (Duty so Ends these 24 hours Date By Ob- 30. 04 South Long By Obs- 11. 04 West)

Monday Oct- 19th 1835

All these 24 hours strong Breezes and clear weather steering S. By West under single Reefed top sails a heavy sea running all hands Employed in ships (Duty so Ends Date By Ob- 31. 39 Long- 11. 40 West)

Tuesday Oct- 20th 1835

All these 24 hours strong Breezes and clear weather winds from E. S. East steering South under single Reefed top sails Unbent top Gallant steering sails and sent Down the boom unbent the Flying Jib and Rigger in the boom so Ends Date- 33. 22 South Long By Obs- 11. 10 West

Wednesday Oct. 21st 1835

All these 24 hours strong Breezes from E. N. East and clear weather steering S. S. East By Compass saw hump Backs at 10 P.M. took in top Gallant sails all hands Employed in ships (Duty so Ends Date- 35. 41 South Long- 12. 00 West)

Thursday Oct. 22^d 1835

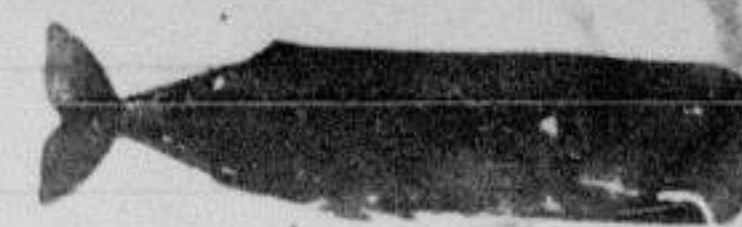
All these 24 hours strong Breezes from the N. East steering East S. East saw two Right whales (Down Boats but did not get fast so Ends Date 36. 19 South)

Friday Oct. 23^d 1835

All these 24 hours strong Breezes from the Northward steering East so Ends Date 36. 16 South Long-

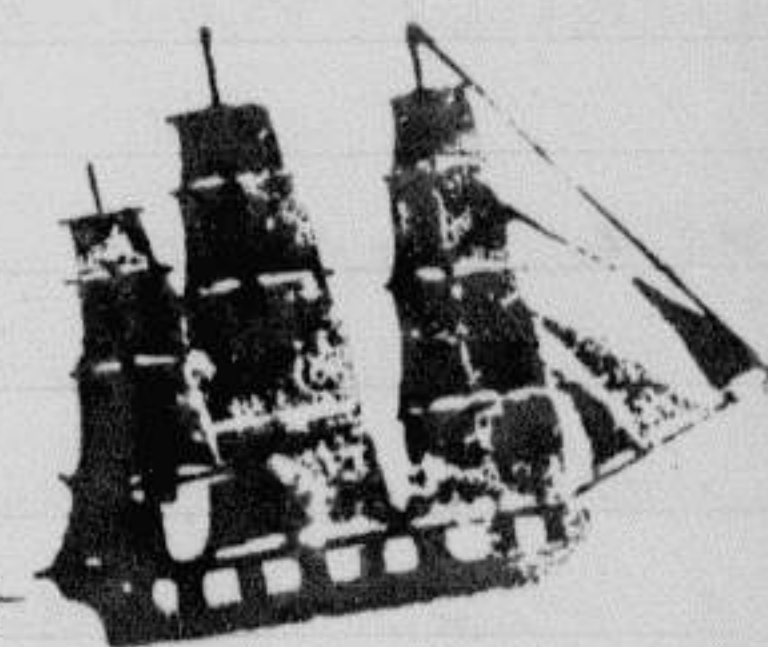
Saturday Oct 24th 1835

All these 24 hours strong Breezes and clear weather at 8 a.m. Raised spermin wales Down Boats Starboard Boat struck and Driven Starboard Boat struck and killed one and took him along side at 3 P.M. spoke ship Bogue Capt Mather no Oil so Ends Date By Ob- 35. 44 South Long-



Sunday Oct- 25th 1835

All these 24 hours light Breezes from N. N. East and clear weather at 8 a.m. spoke Brig Gole Hunter of Colgarion Capt. Allen with 80 lbs of spermin Oil at 4 P.M. finished cutting in the whale so Ends these 24 hours Date- 36. 40 South

All these 24 hours light Breezes from N. and East steering East By Ob, all hands Employed in ships (Duty saw fin Backs so Ends these 24 hours Date By Ob 36. 28, S. Long-

Tuesday Oct 27th 1835

All these 24 hours light Breezes from the North and pleasant weather all hands Employed in stowing down Oil so Ends these 24 hours Date 36. 00 South Long-

Wednesday Oct- 28th 1835

All these 24 hours light Breezes and fine weather Spoke ship Liverpool of New Bedford Capt. Fisher 1 Right whale and 150 lbs of spermin also Ship Asia of Larve Capt Jay no Oil Ship Eagle of Nantucket in sight cutting in 2 spermin whale winds N. N. West steering N. E. By East all hands Employed in stowing down Oil so Ends these 24 hours Date By Ob- 34. 35 South Long-
