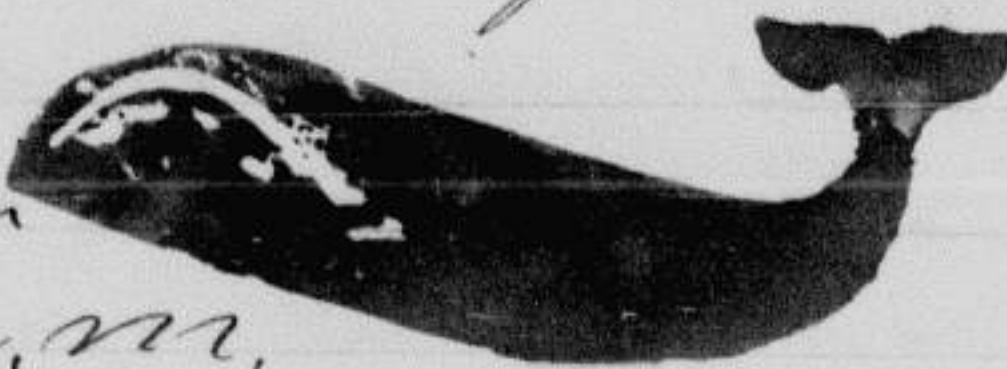


Tuesday Novr 10th 1835

First part of these 24 hours strong Breezes from the S. West Middle and latter Parts squalls of Rain all hands Employed in stowing stow oil At 8 A.M. struck a whale to the waste Boat Larboard Boat Whilled it at 9 A.M. commenced cutting in as Ends there 24 hours Latd - 33. 43 South Long -



Wednesday Novr 11th 1835

All these 24 hours fresh Breezes and clear weather all hands Employed in ship Duty and Boiling oil steering to the Eastward at sunset Luffed to the wind so Ends Latd By Ob. 33. 50 South Long -

Thursday Novr 12th 1835

First part of these 24 hours calm Middle and latter Parts moderate Breezes from the S. West steering S. E. By Compass 2 points Variation all hands Employed in stowing (Saw oil so Ends Latd 33. 56 South Long By Obs. 14. 00 East

Friday Novr 13th 1835

First part of these 24 hours strong Breezes and clear weather winds from W. N. West at 1 A.M. took in the mainsail and Gib and Jumble Reefed the top sails middle and latter Parts moderate steering S. East set the Gib and main sail so Ends Latd 34. 45 South Long By Obs. 16. 14 East

Saturday Novr 14th 1835

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from S. W. Middle and latter Parts more moderate steering South, East at meridian lashed ship to the East were all hands Employed in ship Duty so Ends Latd By Obs. 35. 12 South Long By Obs. 15. 25 East

Sunday Novr 15th 1835

All these 24 hours fine Breezes and good weather steering S. E. East By the wind At 2 A.M. lashed to the westward saw a ship steering West so Ends there 24 hours Latd - 35. 12 South Long - 15. 20 East

Monday Novr 16th 1835

All these 24 hours strong Breezes and clear weather steering S. E. 1/2 East By Compass 2 1/2 Points Variation so Ends Latd By Obs. 36. 00 South Long - 15. 21 East -

Tuesday Novr 17th 1835

All these 24 hours strong Breezes and clear weather steering S. E. By South By Compass Variation two points westerly so Ends there 24 hours Latd By Obs. 36. 30 South Long - 21. 54 East

Wednesday Novr 18th 1835

First part of these 24 hours strong Breezes from the South Middle and latter Parts light winds with a heavy sea so Ends Latd By Obs. 36. 55 South Long 23. 10 E,

Thursday Novr 19th 1835

All these 24 hours calm with a N. N. West current all hands Employed in ship Duty so Ends there 24 hours Latd By Obs. 36. 44 South Long By Obs. 22. 10 East

Friday Novr 20th 1835

First and middle parts of these 24 hours calm latter Part light Breezes from the westward steering S. E. by Compass 2 1/2 Points Variation so Ends Latd - 36. 51 South Long By Obs. 24. 10 East

Saturday Novr 21st 1835

All these 24 hours moderate Breezes and fine weather steering South East By Compass all hands Employed in Bending and Repairing sails so Ends Latd By Obs. 37. 08 S, Long By Obs. 27. 50 East
