Continues much the same as above steering
to the southward and Westward with all
prudent sail set Middle and Latter Parts
much the same so Eners there 24 hours
Lat By Obs - 26. 03 South Long By C. R. 93. 04 East

Wednesday May 4th 1836
Continues much the same as above the first
part steering to the Southward and Westward
saw Nothing Remarkable Middle and Latter
parts more moderate so Eners there 24 hours
Lat By Obs - 28. 16 South Long By Obs 93. 24 East

Thursday May 5th 1836
Continues gentle breezes and clear weather steering
By the wind to the south and West Middle
and Latter Parts much the same so Eners
Lat By Obs - 29 South Long By Obs 93. 25 East

Friday May 6th 1836
Continues Light Variable winds steering South
East By Compass Middle and Latter Parts
much the same so Eners there 24 hours
Lat By Obs - 30. 01 South Long By C. R. 94. 11 East

Saturday May 7th 1836
Continues Light winds from the south with
fine weather steering S. East By Compass
Middle and Latter Parts the same so Eners
Lat By Obs - 30. 50 South Long 95. 2 East

Sunday May 8th 1836
Continues Light Variable N. E. winds and
fine weather steering S. East By Compass
Middle and Latter Parts much the same
so Eners there 24 hours Lat By Obs - 31. 05 South
Long By Obs - 96. 20 East

Monday May 9th 1836
Continues much the same as above steering
East By Compass Middle and Latter Parts winds
from the North and west and cloudy weather
steering S. East By Compass so Eners there 24 hours
Lat By Obs - 32. 12 South Long By Obs 97. 32 East

Tuesday May 10th 1836
Continues ^{strong} winds from the N. and West and cloudy
weather steering East S. East By Compass Middle
and Latter Parts much the same so Eners
Lat By Obs - 32. 03 South Long By C. R. 99. 25 East

Wednesday May 11th 1836
Continues strong winds from the North and cloudy
weather steering East By Compass Middle and
Latter Parts Light winds with frequent showers
of Rain so Eners there 24 hours Lat - 32. 23 South
Long By C. R. 101. 58 East

Thursday May 12th 1836
These 24 hours commenced with strong winds from the
S. S. West with frequent squalls of Rain steering
S. E. East By Compass one point Variation Middle
and Latter Parts more moderate so Eners there 24 hours
Lat By Obs - 30. 44 South Long By Obs 104. 58 East

Friday May 13th 1836
Continues much the same as above steering S. East
By East By Compass Middle and Latter Parts
much the same so Eners there 24 hours Lat - 28. 52
Long - 107. 48 East

Saturday May 14th 1836
These 24 hours continues strong winds from the S. W.
with clear weather steering S. E. By East By
Compass 1 point Variation Middle and
Latter parts much the same at 7 A M saw
a ship sailing at 10 Past 10 spoke her Ship
Stephanie New Bedford Capt Hathaway
with ⁶⁵⁰ 650 lbs of Oil so eners Lat. 27. 20 South Long 109. 33
East
