Friday August 12th 1836
Continues Light winds and pleasant weather
steering N. East Middle and Latter Parts
much the same so even Lat^s By Obs - 17.23.9,
Long -

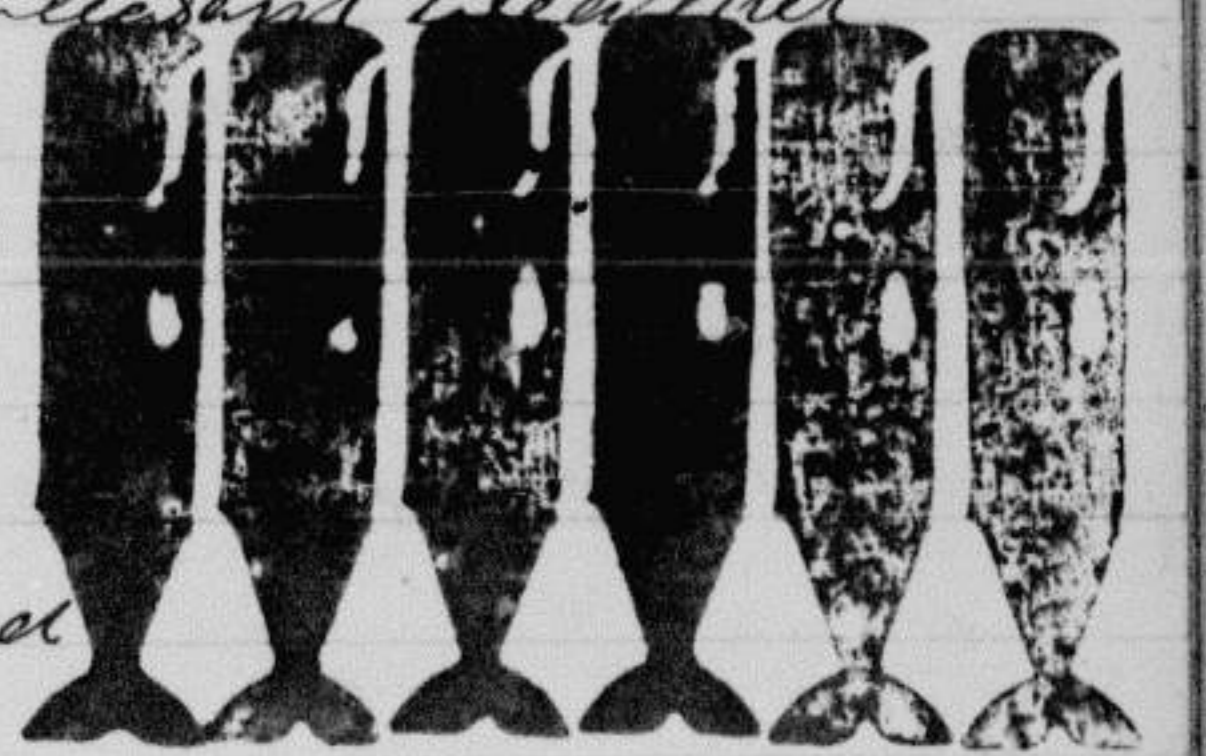
Saturday August 13th 1836
Commenced strong winds and pleasant weather
Middle and Latter Parts fine breezes and
clear weather so even there 24 hours Lat^s - 16.35 South
Long -

Sunday August 14th 1836
Continues strong breezes and clear weather
steering N. East By compass Middle parts much
the same Latter Parts Light winds and fine
weather so even Lat^s By Obs - 14.46 South
Long By Obs -

Monday August 15th 1836
Continues Light winds and fine weather steering
N. East By compass at 6 P.M. Double Reefed the top
sails at Day Light made sail again Middle
and Latter Parts much the same so even
Lat^s By Obs - 14.18 South Long By Obs -

Tuesday August 16th 1836
Continues much the same as above steering By
the wind to the N. and East Middle and
Latter Parts much the same so even there 24 hours
Lat^s By Obs - 13.52 South Long By Obs -

Wednesday August 17th 1836
Continues Light winds and pleasant weather
steering to the Eastward Middle
and Latter parts much the same
at 9 A.M. Saw a school of
sperm whales (Down Boat
starboard Boat struck and killed
two Starboard Boat struck and
killed one Waite Boat struck and killed three
so even there 24 hours Lat^s - 13.30 South
Long - 118.48 East



Thursday August 18th 1836
Continues much the same as above at 3 P.M. took
the 6 whales along side and cut in two of them
and set the watch Middle Parts much the same
at Day Light Commenced cutting again so even
Lat^s By Obs - 13.19 South Long By Obs - 119.00 East

Friday August 19th 1836
Continues Light winds and fine weather at 4 P.M.
finished cutting and commenced Boiling Middle
and Latter parts much the same so even there
24 hours Lat^s By Obs - 13.25 South Long - 119.08 East

Saturday August 20th 1836
Still continues Light winds and fine weather
at 1 P.M. Saw a large sperm whale going
quick to the windward all hands Employed
in Boiling Middle and Latter Parts much
the same so even Lat^s By Obs - 13.01 South
Long By Obs - 119.18 East

Sunday August 21st 1836
Continues Light winds and pleasant weather
All hands Employed in Boiling Setting up shooks
&c. - At 11 P.M. finished Boiling Middle and
Latter parts Gentle breezes; All hands Employed
in cooping Oil &c. so even Lat^s By Obs - 12.44 South
Long By Obs - 119.30 East
