Friday Oct 28th 1836

Continues light winds and pleasant weather
Saw nothing remarkable Middle and latter
parts much the same so ends Lat. - 17. 55 South
Long. - 115. 45 East.

Saturday Oct 29th 1836

Continues light winds and fine weather all
hands Employed in repairing the main sail
Middle and latter parts much the same so ends
Lat. By Obs. - 18. 00 South - Long. - 116. 13 East

Sunday Oct 30th 1836

Continues much the same as above All hands
Employed in repairing the main sail Caught
a shovel nose shark Saw fin Backs and hump
Backs middle and latter parts much the
same so ends Lat. By Obs. - 18. 31 South
Long By Obs. - 116. 43 East

Continues light winds and fine weather steering
by the wind to the N. and West Middle and
latter parts much the same steering N. N. West
so ends Lat. By Obs. - 17. 53 South Long. -

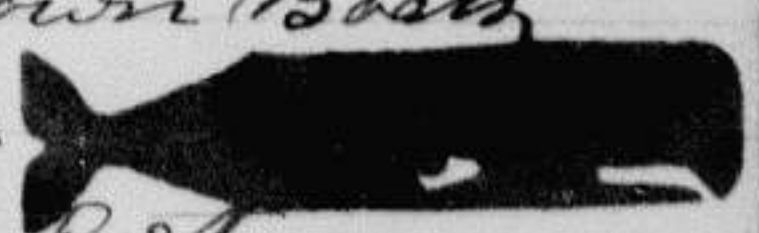
Friday Nov 4th 1836

Commenced fine breezes and pleasant weather Saw
black fish middle and latter parts the same
steering to the Northward so ends Lat. By Obs. - 17. 12
Long By Obs. - 116. 15 East

Saturday Nov 5th 1836

Continues much the same as above steering to
the Northward Middle parts much the same
latter parts steering N. East so ends these 24 hours
Lat. By Obs. - 16. 30 South Long. -

Sunday Nov 6th 1836

Continues light winds and fine weather steering N. E.
Saw black fish middle and latter parts much the same
at 9 A.M. saw a school of sperm whales down boats
Latter boat struck killed and took him 
along side so ends Lat. 15. 43 S. Long 118. 08 East
