

Friday March 31st 1837

Continued moderate Breezes and fine weather
At 4 P.M. took the whales along side and cut
him in and set the watch. Quarter watches Middle
and Latter parts much the same at 8 A.M.
Commenced Boiling so ended Day.

Saturday April 1st 1837

Continued much the same as above at meridian
Saw sperm whales Down two Boats did not strike
Middle and Latter parts much the same all
hands Employed in Boiling at Meridian finished
Boiling so ended Day By 6.15.00 South Gong.

Sunday April 2^d 1837

Continued light winds and fine weather steering
By the wind Middle and parts much the same
So ended Day By 6.15.00 Gong.

Monday April 3^d 1837

Continued light winds and fine weather saw porpoise
Middle parts much the same at 6 A.M. Commenced
stowing down Oil at meridian finished so ended
Day Gong.

Tuesday April 4th 1837

Continued pleasant weather steering N. By
Compass with all sails set Middle and Latter
parts the same so ended Day.

Wednesday April 5th 1837

Commenced strong Breezes and fine weather steering
By the wind to the N. and E. at 6 P.M. saw a school
of sperm whales did not lower; it
being sunset Middle and Latter parts
much the same at day light saw sperm whales
down Boats White Boat struck and killed a whale
and took him along side and cut him in
so ended these 24 hours Day Gong.



Thursday April 6th 1837

Commenced strong Breezes and fine weather at 2 P.M.
Saw Breches supposed to be sperm whales at 3 P.M.
commenced Boiling Middle and Latter parts the
same steering By the wind so ended Day.

Friday April 7th 1837

Begins with pleasant Breezes and fine weather at 5
P.M. finished Boiling Middle and Latter parts
much the same steering By the wind so ended Day.

Saturday April 8th 1837

First part of these 24 hours fresh Breezes from the E.
and fine weather steering By the wind Middle
and Latter parts much the same so ended
Day.

Sunday April 9th 1837

Continued strong Breezes and clear weather saw
nothing remarkable steering By the wind Middle
and Latter parts more moderate saw fin backs
so ended these 24 hours Day Gong.

Monday April 10th 1837

Continued light Breezes and fine weather steering
By the wind to the Northward and Eastward all
hands Employed in stowing down Oil at 3 P.M.
finished stowing the Oil Middle and
Latter parts much the same at 11
A.M. saw sperm whales Down Boats
Starboard and Main Boat struck and killed
each a whale so ended these 24 hours Day

Tuesday April 11th 1837

Continued much the same as above at 2 P.M. took
the whales along side and cut one in and commenced
Boiling at 7 A.M. commenced in the other whale at 9
finished Middle and Latter parts much the same
so ended these 24 hours Day Gong.
