Continues Light winds and fine weather. All hands Employed in Boiling Middle and Gutter parts much the same at 7 A.M. Saw sperm whale Down Boat. Starboard Boat struck him. Fine fasted. Came on Board so ends. Gato.

Thursday April 13th 1837

Commenced strong breezes and fine weather at 7 P.M. Coaled Down and set the watch. Boat crews middle and Gutter parts Light winds so ends. Gato.

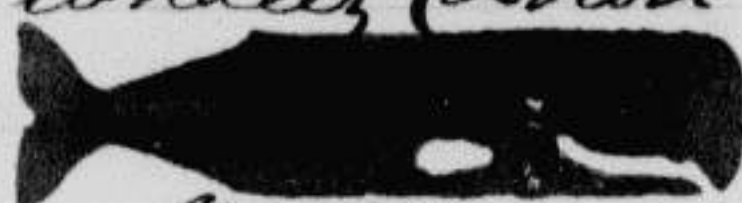
Friday April 14th 1837

Continues Light winds and fine weather at 1 P.M. Commenced stowing Down Oil in the fore hold. Middle and Gutter parts much the same. All hands Employed in Stowing down Oil so ends. Gato.

Saturday April 15th 1837

Continues much the same as above at 2 P.M. finished stowing Down Oil at 3 P.M. Saw sperm whale Down Boat. Starboard Boat struck and killed



one and took him along side with a stoven Boat at 6 A.M. Commenced cutting at 9 A.M. finished and commenced Boiling so ends. Gato.

Sunday April 16th 1837

Continues Light winds and fine weather. All hands Employed in Boiling Middle and Gutter parts much the same at 10 A.M. finished Boiling so ends. Gato.

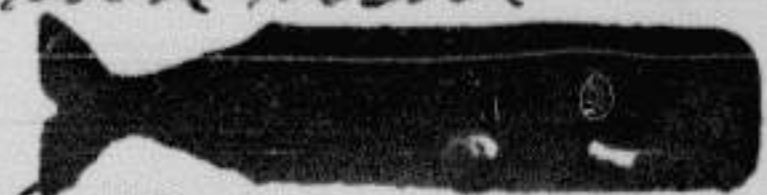
Monday April 17th 1837

Continues Light winds and fine weather at 2 P.M. Saw a sperm whale Down Boat but did not strike Middle and Gutter parts much the same at 9 A.M. Saw a sperm whale so ends. Gato.

Tuesday April 18th 1837

Continues much the same as above at meridian Down Boat and pursued the whale at 5 P.M. the White Boat struck and killed the whale and took him along side and set the watch at Day.



Light commenced cutting in the whale at 10 A.M. finished and commenced Boiling so ends. These 24 hours. Gato By Ob. 17° 50 South Gong - 118° 14 East

Wednesday April 19th 1837

Continues Light winds and fine weather at meridian. Picked away for the Island of Madagascar homeward Bound. All hands Employed in Boiling Middle and Gutter parts much the same at 9 A.M. finished Boiling at 10 commenced stowing Down Oil so ends. Gato By Ob. 17° 56 South Gong - 114° 14 East

Thursday April 20th 1837

Continues Light winds and fine weather. Steering West By South with all sail set Middle and Gutter parts much the same so ends. These 24 hours.

Gato By Ob. 18° 22 South Gong By Ob. 112° 48 East

Friday April 21st 1837

Continues Light winds and fine weather. Steering West By South Middle and Gutter parts much the same. At 7 A.M. commenced stowing down Oil so ends. Gato By Ob. 18° 39 South Gong - 110° 59 East

Saturday April 22nd 1837

Continues much the same as above steering West By South By compass at 5 P.M. finished stowing down Oil Middle and Gutter parts much the same so ends. Gato - 19° 10 South Gong - 109° 43 East

Sunday April 23rd 1837

Continues moderate breezes and fine Pleasant weather. Steering West By South with all sail set Middle and Gutter parts much the same so ends. Gato - 19° 14 South Gong - 107° 11 East
