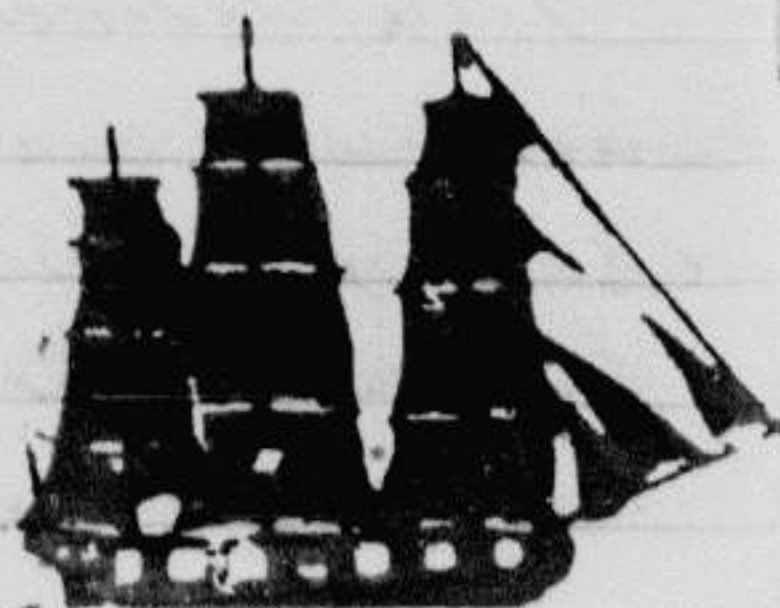
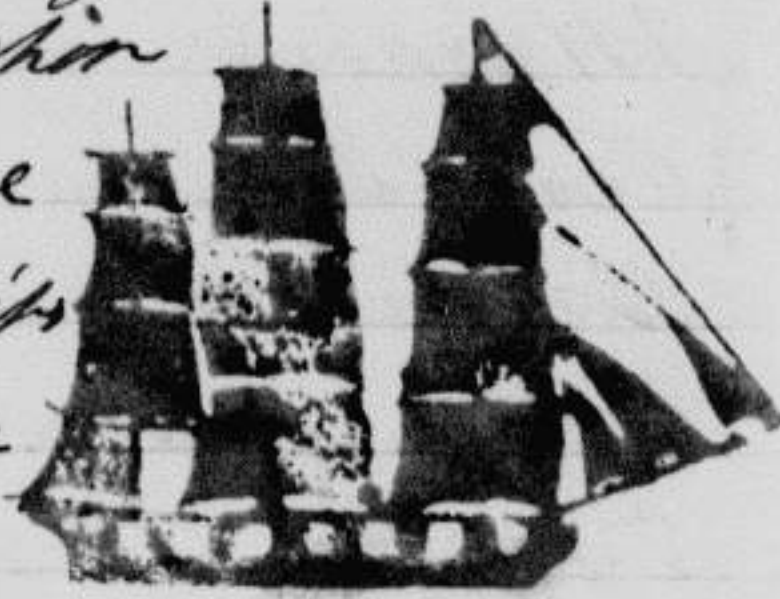


Coast of Africa Wednesday June 14th 1837

 Lat By Obs. 34.00 South Long. 18.38 East

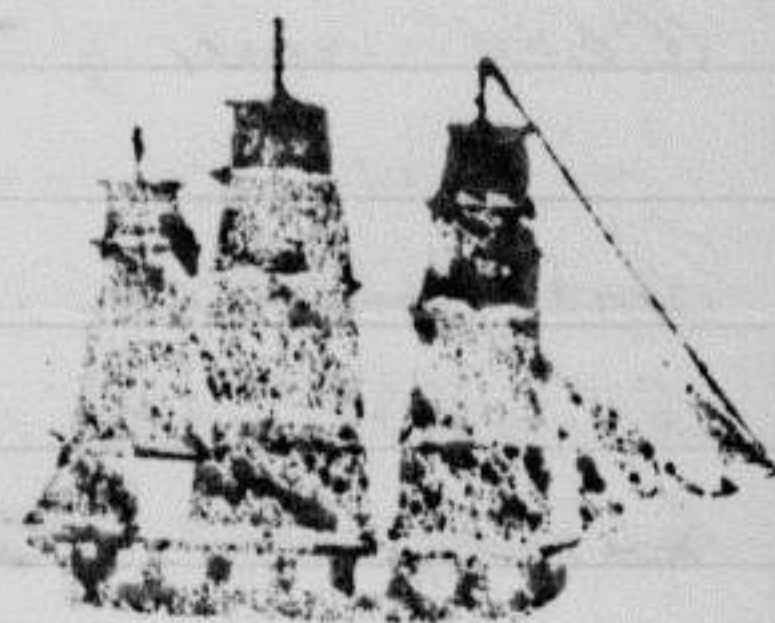
Coast of Africa Thursday June 15th 1837
 Commences more moderate Steering N. N. West By
 Compass At 2 P.M. made the Land again Bearing
 N. N. East Dist 8 Leagues At 4 P.M. made the
 Cape of Good Hope Bearing N. By East Dist 9
 Leagues At 6 P.M. Viewed Ship to the N. and East
 Middle and latter parts much the same the ship
 lying off and on the Cape of Good Hope At Day
 Night Bore away for St. Simons Bay scenes -
 Lat Long -

Friday June 16th 1837
 Continues moderate Breezes and squally weather
 All hands Employed in clearing the anchor
 and bending the chain At 4 P.M. Came
 to anchor in Simons town harbour; Ship
 lying at anchor in the harbour ship Eagle
 of London from the Island France the
 Frigate - Thetis of 46 guns and several small
 crafts, Middle and latter parts much the same
 the starboard water on shore on Liberty At 6 P.M.
 sent a shore and got a new anchor The starboard
 water Employed in bending the new anchor and
 taking the other on Deck so ever, Lat Long -

Saturday June 17th 1837
 Starboard water on shore on Liberty the
 starboard water Employed in ship
 Duty Arrived Ship Isaacica from
 Calcutta Bound to London so ever,
 Near 24 hours Lat By Obs. Long -

 of Bulwarks and Leaky scenes



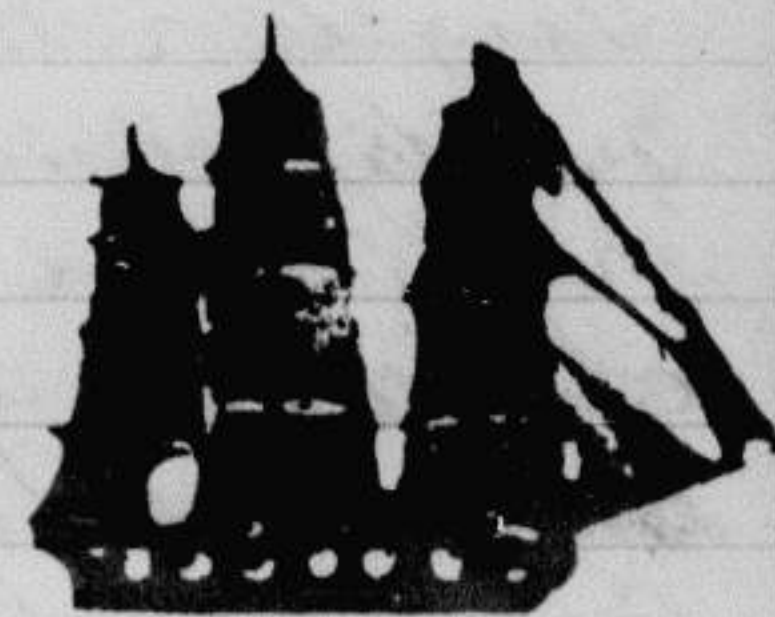
