Friday August 4th 1837

Continued moderate Breezes and fine weather steering N. West By N. By compass All hands Employed in taring the Riggings &c. Middle and Latter Parts much the same so ends Lat 8.56 South Long - 14.27 West

Saturday August 5th 1837

These 24 hours strong Breezes and fine weather steering N. West By N. By compass All hands Employed in taring Riggings Middle and Latter Parts Light Breezes and fine weather so ends Lat -

Continued moderate Breezes and fine weather steering the same as above All hands Employed in fitting the Riggings &c. At 4 P. M. saw a school of sperm whales Down two Boats and pursued the whales at sunset gave up the chase and came on Board Middle and Latter parts frequent squalls of rain saw nothing Remarkable so ends Lat By Obs. 6.26 South Long -

Continued much the same as above steering N. West By N. By compass Middle Parts strong Breezes Latter Parts Light Breezes and fine weather All hands Employed in fitting Riggings &c. so ends Lat -
